### MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN A PARTNER ORGANIZATION OR INDIVIDUAL AND OAKLAND UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

#### I. Parties

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is to establish a relationship between Oaldand Unified School District ("OUSD") and the <u>Alameda County Resource Conservation District</u> (CONTRACTOR).

WHEREAS, the CONTRACTOR's services or program described in this MOU will be provided at no cost to OUSD, the students, or the parents; and

BOTH PARTIES HEREBY enter into this MOU to enable CONTRACTOR to provide said program(s) selected in Section II of the MOU.

#### II. Program Name(s)

Unless otherwise agreed to in writing by the parties, the Program(s) governed by this MOU are the following:

Sunol AgPark In-School Program

Sunol AgPark Field Trips

#### III. CONTRACTOR Responsibilities/Scope of Services

- A. Provide a description of the services that your program(s) will be providing to OUSD. Please be specific by answering all of the following questions.
  - 1. A brief description of the type of services your program(s) generally provides.

    In-School Programs open discussions on the local watershed, sustainable, organic farming and how to prepare for the Sunol AgPark field trip.

    Field Trips explore: watershed stewardship; how and where local farms produce healthy food using clean water and healthy soil; sustainability and cultural aspects of diverse of crops; and natural habitat in and around the farm.

Current outdoor educators have provided farm education for a minimum of two years. All educators have bachelors degrees and some advanced degrees. Curriculum presented is based on "Farming in the Watershed" developed and tested in 2010 by SAGE with advice from East Bay Regional Parks Division.

- B. Ensure that all CONTRACTOR personnel, including subcontractors, will comply with any policy and systems in place at OUSD and School(s). This includes, but is not limited to the following:
  - 1. **Drug and Smoke Free**—No drugs, alcohol, and/or smoking are allowed at any time in any buildings and/or grounds on OUSD property. No students, staff, visitors, CONTRACTORS, or subcontractors are to use drugs at these School(s).
  - 2. **Anti-Discrimination**—It is the policy of OUSD that in connection with CONTRACTOR's services under this MOU there shall be no discrimination against any employee engaged in the work because of

race, color, ancestry, national origin, religious creed, physical disability, medical condition, marital status, sexual orientation, gender, age, or other legally protected class. Therefore, the CONTRACTOR agrees to comply with all applicable Federal and California laws.

- 3. **Conflict of Interest**—CONTRACTOR shall abide by and be subject to all applicable OUSD policies, regulations, statutes or other laws regarding conflict of interest. CONTRACTOR shall not hire any OUSD employee to perform the services in this MOU, and affirms that to the best of its knowledge no such conflict presently exists. CONTRACTOR agrees to alert OUSD in writing if and when a potential conflict arises.
- 4. Family Education Rights and Privacy Act—CONTRACTOR shall observe all District policies and regulations, and state and federal laws, including the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act of 1974, commonly known as FERPA, related to the confidentiality of pupil and personnel records.
- C. **Tuberculosis Screening:** CONTRACTOR is required to screen employees and agents who will be present at OUSD sites during the current school year. CONTRACTOR affirms that each person has current proof of negative TB testing on file and TB results are monitored. Please see **Section IV** for the relevant documentation that is required.
- Fingerprinting of Employees and Agents. The fingerprinting and criminal D. background investigation requirements of Education Code section 45125.1 apply to CONTRACTOR's services under this Agreement and CONTRACTOR certifies its compliance with these provisions as follows: "CONTRACTOR certifles that CONTRACTOR has complied with the fingerprinting and criminal background investigation requirements of Education Code section 45125.1 with respect to all CONTRACTOR's employees, subcontractors, agents, and subcontractors' employees or agents ("Employees") regardless of whether those Employees are paid or unpaid, concurrently employed by OUSD, or acting as independent contractors of CONTRACTOR, who may have contact with OUSD pupils in the course of providing services pursuant to the MOU, and the California Department of Justice has determined that none of those Employees has been convicted of a felony, as that term is defined in Education Code section 45122.1. CONTRACTOR further certifies that it has received and reviewed fingerprint results for each of its Employees and CONTRACTOR has requested and reviews subsequent arrest records for all Employees who may come into contact with OUSD pupils in providing services to the District under this MOU. Please see Section IV for the relevant documentation that is required.

In the event that OUSD, in its sole discretion, at any time during the term of this MOU, desires the removal of any CONTRACTOR related person, employee, representative or agent from any OUSD school; site; and/or property, CONTRACTOR shall immediately, upon receiving notice from OUSD of such desire, cause the removal of such person or persons.

#### E. Insurance

- 1. General Liability: EITHER (a) CONTRACTOR maintains general liability insurance that names OUSD as an additional insured, for operations, students, volunteers, and personnel at location where CONTRACTOR provides programs/services with at least \$1 Million in coverage, and furnish certificate of said insurance to OUSD OR (b) CONTRACTOR is not required to maintain general liability insurance under this agreement if the Risk Management Officer signs a waiver of insurance. Please see Section IV for the relevant documentation that is required.
- 2. Workers' Compensation: If CONTRACTOR employs any person to perform work in connection with this MOU, CONTRACTOR shall procure and maintain at all times during the performance of such work, Workers' Compensation Insurance in conformance with the laws of the State of California and federal laws, when applicable. The CONTRACTORS' Employers' Liability Insurance shall not be less than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) per accident or disease. Please see Section IV for the relevant documentation that is required.

- F. At the request of School(s) or OUSD staff, provide reasonable data and information to students participating in the CONTRACTOR's program.

- G. Confidentiality—CONTRACTOR shall maintain strict confidentiality of all information about individual students received under this MOU and will not disseminate such information without the express written consent of OUSD. CONTRACTOR will comply with FERPA, and will be allowed to use the data received to solicit funding to continue to expand its services/program, so long as there is no information from which the identity of any student in the CONTRACTOR's program as a participant could be made.
- H. Register With/Update Community Partner Platform—Contractor shall register in OUSD's Community Partner Platform database and perform annual updates by August 31 of each year, to maintain full and complete up-to-date information.

#### IV. Required Documents

CONTRACTOR CANNOT commence the services agreed to in this MOU until it has submitted the following documents:

#### A. TB and Fingerprinting Clearance:

#### **Contractor (Individual):**

Submit clearance letter from authorized agency verifying individual has been Fingerprinted/Criminal Background Checked for this current fiscal year. Additionally, please provide documentation from health care provider showing negative TB status of individual within the last four years.

#### Contractor (Agency):

Attach clearance letter from Agency/Community-Based Organization/Non-Profit Organization on agency letterhead verifying all personnel, including subcontractors, have been Fingerprinted/Criminal Background Checked and have TB clearance for this current fiscal year and signed by authorized personnel.

#### B. <u>Insurance</u>:

#### Contractor (Individual/Agency):

Please attach documentation of either proof of insurance, or a waiver signed by the Risk Management Officer. The additional insured address must read: Oakland Unified School District, Attention: Risk Management, 1000 Broadway Suite 440, Oakland, CA 94607. Waiver of insurance does not release CONTRACTOR from responsibility for any claim or demand.

#### V. Responsibilities of Oakland Unified School District

- A. **Space**—Provide a suitable classroom or space at the participating School(s), to be agreed upon by School(s) and the CONTRACTOR.
- B. **Janitorial Service**—Provide necessary services to maintain this space, including janitorial services, maintenance, utilities, and technology support.
- C. Data—Ensure that CONTRACTOR has reasonable access to student assessment and evaluation data necessary to inform instruction and periodically review student progress and to provide the study.
  - 1. For the purpose of cohort determination, for instructional purposes, or for academic research purposes, at the sole discretion of OUSD, provide CONTRACTOR access to student assessment data for all students at School(s) including, but not limited to, state test scores and site-based assessments. Students identified may be protected by the use of ID numbers.
  - 2. Provide CONTRACTOR with any other student information reasonably necessary to provide its services consistent with the CONTRACTOR's program and to evaluate the impact of its program on students at School(s).

#### VI. Duration

This MOU is for the 7/01/2017 -- 6/30/2020 period.

## PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH

OAKLAND UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT and ALAMEDA COUNTY RESOURCE CONSERVATION DISTRICT (ACRCD)

#### Scope of Work

Summary of Services and Expected Outcomes

Alameda County Resource Conservation District will provide:

<u>On-Farm Education at Sunol AgPark (4th-6th grade)</u>: Education programs at the AgPark focus on four of the most successful *Farming in the Watershed lessons*. Students also participate in a 'farm chore,' in which small groups of students work with a Sunol AgPark farmer and help with a specific farm task, including harvesting crops, gleaning fields, planting, weeding and digging rows. Participation in these activities will help students achieve the following:

#### **Emotional:**

1. Feel more comfortable and confident outside

#### Cognitive:

- 1. Appreciate that farming is dynamic and dependent upon ecological services, natural and cultural resources
- 2. Appreciate that farming is a labor-intensive activity
- 3. Value the connection between protected farm land with organic practices and open space as important to the health of humans, wildlife and water.

#### Behavioral:

- Be inspired to increase positive impact, i.e. plant or work in a home/school/community garden or eat more healthy foods,
- 2. To change behavior in order to reduce their own impact on water and watersheds
- 3. Increase observation skills.

<u>In-School Education Program (4th-6th grade)</u>: Schools that have field trips to the AgPark are encouraged to sign up for an In-school program to prepare students for the AgPark field trip program and watershed experience. Participation in these activities will help students achieve the following:

#### **Emotional:**

1. Feel more comfortable in a natural area and on a farm

#### Cognitive:

- 1. Understand geography of watersheds
- 2. See relationships between soils and water, and stewardship of the watershed

#### Behavioral:

1. Bring appropriate clothing, sunscreen, water bottles, hats and backpacks on the field trip

2. Understand a "zero waste" lunch, contribute through compostable lunch remains and pack out landfill waste

ACRCD will provide bus transportation to and from the Sunol AgPark with OUSD approved bus companies at no cost to the District. ACRCD will ask individual schools to apply to Science By Nature transportation grants allocated to schools with 70% participation in school lunch programs. Funds generated by the grants will assist in payment for transportation and go to ACRCD.

#### Statement of Qualifications

ACRDC organizational description and successes

The Alameda County Resource Conservation District (ACRCD) and the USDA Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) collaborate as the Conservation Partnership to serve as the lead conservation agency in Alameda County. ACRCD provides technical and educational services for natural resource conservation and agriculture enhancement. The Partnership collaborates with many partners including private landowners, local, state and federal agencies and other organizations to develop and implement various conservation and agricultural strategies.

ACRCD has provided a number of successful youth education programs throughout Alameda County. These include:

- Watershed Education Project with Palomares school in Castro Valley involving a watershed expo, curriculum development, teacher training and a junior rangers program.
- Range camp, designed to introduce young men and woman age 15-18, to the extent, importance and value of California's rangeland resources through interaction with recognized professionals in both classroom and field sessions.
- Hands-On-Conservation, a county-wide educational program that provides opportunities for youth to learn about natural resources conservation through active participation in stewardship and agriculture enhancement activities on public and private property.

In 2017, ACRCD assumed management of the Sunol AgPark farm education programs formerly overseen by the non-profit organization SAGE (Sustainable Agricultural Education). Over the course of the last six years, SAGE has served more than 10,000 children, offering filed trip experiences for students living in urban areas to the Sunol AgPark. Using the curriculum developed by SAGE and hiring many of SAGE's qualified outdoor educators, ACRCD successfully opened the program to eight local elementary schools in Spring 2017.
