#### Narrative: Please provide the reasoning as to why the full Measure G1 allocation was not spent.

The RULER materials for our new Social Emotional Learning curriculum were less expensive than originally budgeted. We were planning to send staff to RULER training, but due to uncertainties with staffing going into 18-19, it did not make sense to invest in training for staff that was unlikely to return. Instead, we have a need to use the funds for additional SEL training of our campus supervisors this year so that we can provide a positive, safe school. In addition, our college counseling intern has taken on a Career Fair project for her internship which will be new this year and will promote college/career readiness, so having funds to get materials and invite more guests/speakers will be beneficial for the school. Our school sees a very direct connection between the Career Fair and Measure G1's intention to create a safe, positive culture. We are looking for opportunities to shift the culture of GSP to one in which students make better decisions because they have higher engagement in school, and the Career Fair for middle school will serve that purpose. Some of the funds will be used for raffle prizes and snacks during the Career Fair to better engage middle schoolers in this experience.
