




# Academic Performance - Comparison Schools









EBIA's overall pupil outcomes match or outperform comparison schools.

EBIA's subpopulation pupil outcomes outperform comparison schools.





- We have had ZERO expulsions in our 4-year history, and a less than 4% suspension rate.
