• \$850 per pupil	X	By the end of the 2018/19 school year, ARISE will no longer be in a piloting stage, having fully implemented all assessment categories of a Linked Learning school (the outside WBL experience, Capstone course, and Grad Profile presentations are the last things we are piloting). The areas, which we are at a 2/2.5 currently, are areas we will see growth in by the end of the 2019 spring semester. ARISE will be eligible for Silver Certification status by the December 21st deadline having met all requirements thus far to align with Linked Learning standards (we also have started our progress towards gold status in several areas). Remaining funds this year will go towards spring plans and implementation to support the strengthening of our 4 pillars work, as well as preparing for changes around our summer schedule (i.e. an addition to summer school, adding freshman bridge, and enrichment courses for all students; more in the implementation plan). We also have a new need, due to our piloting of capstone, to hire a <i>Work-Based Learning Liaison</i> to assist in student intern/externships in the spring. We are planning intensive planning meetings as a curriculum development to better plan and rollout our Master Schedules changes, and stronger-aligned curriculum and interdisciplinary projects. We would like to send our returning lead teachers to the Buck Institute training workshops this summer to further support with this process.  ARISE is predicting a growth in student enrollment which will require us to need additional funding to support the incoming students as well as additional staffing needs that will follow.
