Dear Measure G1 Application Review Panel,

I am writing on behalf of the NOCCS Administration to request additional time to complete and submit our 2019-20 Measure G1 Application. Our new leadership team has been focused on meeting the goals of both our 17-18 Carryover and 18-19 G1 Grants (please see our previously submitted midyear reflections and self-assessments for details on these). This winter, we also found that we needed to prioritize limited staff capacity on new grant opportunities (\$25K to \$100K+) now available to NOCCS due to significant recent demographic shifts in our enrollment (Title 1, LPSBG, ESSA CSI).

We remain committed to and deeply appreciative of the G1 program, which has begun to have a direct impact on middle school student learning and experiences in art, music and positive school safety and culture. While it is possible that we may have a draft ready for the panel's May meeting, it is most likely that we will need the remainder of the school year to conduct a thorough engagement and planning process, and then submit our final application when classes resume in the Fall of 2019. We want to take the time we need to ensure that parent and staff feedback has been considered and incorporated into our budget proposal and rationale. Rest assured that our proposal will clearly *supplement*, rather than supplant, existing programs, staff and materials.

While we understand that accommodating this request may not be possible, we appreciate your consideration and are available to answer any questions you may have. Thank you for your service to the students, teachers, staff and families of Oakland's public schools.

In December of 2018, we placed and received an order for \$991.47 worth of art materials. While some of these supplies were bulk-order consumables (pencils, charcoal/pastels, glue, paint), we also took this opportunity to purchase durable items that can be used by students for many years to come, such as easels, rulers, brushes, scissors, glue guns and a pencil sharpener. All of these materials have been integrated into art lessons and have been in use on a near-daily basis since January. Two new areas of art study that these materials have helped to make possible include more art and science integration projects, and art history studies of Kahlo, Matisse and Van Gogh.
