Business and Noninstructional Operations

BP 3220.1 Lottery Funds

The Governing Board intends to use <u>lotteryCalifornia State Lottery</u> funds for supplemental and nonrecurring expenditures <u>whichin</u> support <u>of</u> educational programs and activities. In recognition of the <u>fact that amounts-yearly fluctuations of lottery funds</u> received <u>fromby</u> the <u>California State</u> <u>Lottery fluctuate from year to yeardistrict</u>, the Board shall not commit lottery funds for any purpose until they have been received.

The Board shall establish funding priorities and approve all allocations within the parameters of <u>in accordance with</u> law. Lottery funds allocated for the purchase of instructional materials pursuant to Government Code 8880.4 (Proposition 20, March 2000 ballot initiative) shall be expended on instructional materials as defined in Education Code 60010.

"Instructional materials" means all materials that are designed for use by students and their teachers as a learning resource to help students to acquire facts, skills, or opinions or to develop cognitive processes. Instructional materials may be printed or nonprinted, and may include textbooks, technology-based materials, other educational materials and tests. (Education Code 60010)

Lottery funds allocated by the state for the purchase of instructional materials shall be expended on instructional materials as defined in Education Code 60010. Lottery funds shall not be used to acquire for the acquisition of real estate, build property, construction of school facilities, financefinancing of research, or serve any other noninstructional purpose, such as those related to school maintenance, business. (Government Code 8880.4, 8880.5)

The Board encourages staff<u>For the receipt</u> and community members to participate in determining how<u>expenditure of</u> lottery funds will be used. The, the Superintendent or Deputy Superintendent of Business Services may solicit input through district advisory groups, school site councils, and/or individual students, staff, parents/guardians and community members.

The Superintendent or Deputy Superintendent of Business Services<u>designee</u> shall establish a separate account for the receipt and distribution of lottery funds-that shall be clearly identified as a lottery education account. (Government Code 8880.5)

BP 3220.1 Lottery Funds

The Governing Board intends to use California State Lottery funds for supplemental and nonrecurring expenditures in support of educational programs and activities. In recognition of the yearly fluctuations of lottery funds received by the district, the Board shall not commit lottery funds for any purpose until they have been received.

Lottery funds shall not be used for the acquisition of real property, construction of school facilities, financing of research, or any other noninstructional purpose. (Government Code 8880.4, 8880.5)
