# **ACTION REQUESTED**

Ratification by the Board of Education of President of Board's appointment of Eve Stewart, as an Expertise member, of the 7-11 Committee, effective August 29, 2019, for unexpired term ending April 14, 2021.

# **BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION**

The duties of the 7-11 Committee, as defined by Board Bylaw 9131, are to: (a) Review the projected school enrollment and other data provided by the District to determine the amount of surplus space and real property; (b) Establish a priority list of use of surplus space and real property that will be acceptable to the community; (c) Cause to have circulated throughout the attendance area the priority list and provide for hearings of community input on acceptable uses, including sale or lease for child care development purposes per Education Code section 17458); (d) Make a final determination of limits of tolerance of use; and (e) Provide a report to the Board recommending a determination of whether real property is surplus space and real property. (Education Code § 17390)

There currently exists one vacancy on the 7-11 Committee, requiring the appointment of a person with Expertise either in environmental impact, legal contracts, building codes and land use planning, including, but not limited to, knowledge of the zoning and other land use restrictions of the cities or cities and counties in which surplus space and real property is located.

Ms. Stewart, among other qualifications, has a background in real estate finance and development.

I, pursuant to Board Bylaw 9131, hereby nominate Eve Stewart, as a member of 7-11 Committee, and recommend ratification of her appointment.
