TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES, IN PARTICULAR, BUT NOT EXCLUSIVELY, PARENTS, TEACHERS, BARGAINING UNIT LEADERS, AND MEMBERS OF THE COMMUNITY INTERESTED IN THE AFFAIRS OF THE OAKLAND UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT ON WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 25, 2019**, at a Regular Meeting of the Governing Board ("Board") of the Oakland Unified School District, the Board will hold a public hearing on the District's Sufficiency of Textbooks and Instructional Materials<sup>1</sup>—School Year 2019-2020. Following the conclusion of the hearing the Board shall make a determination, by Resolution, as delineated in (a), (b) and (c) below.

The public hearing will be held, September 25, 2019, at 7:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter, as the matter may be heard, in The Great Room, LaEscuelita Education Center, 1050 2nd Avenue, Oakland, CA 94606-2291.

California Education Code Section 60119 requires that the Board hold a public hearing, within the first eight weeks of school, to determine:

- (a) whether each pupil in each school of the district has sufficient textbooks or instructional materials or both, that are aligned to the content standards adopted by the state board [of education] in each of the following subjects, as appropriate, that are consistent with the content and cycles of curriculum framework adopted by the state board:
  - Mathematics.
  - Science,
  - History-social science,
  - English language arts, including the English language development component of an adopted program; and
- (b) whether each pupil enrolled in a world language or health course has sufficient textbooks or instructional materials that are consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum frameworks adopted by the state board for those subjects; and
- (c) the availability of laboratory science equipment as applicable to science laboratory courses offered in grades 9 to 12 inclusive.

# **ACTION REQUESTED:**

Conduct Public Hearing and, following close of hearing, adopt Resolution No. 1920-0157 – Sufficiency of Textbooks and Instructional Materials – for all schools sites as required by Education Code Section 60119 (Williams Case).

#### BACKGROUND:

In May 2000, the ACLU and other public interest advocates representing students across the state filed a lawsuit against the State of California, the Superintendent of Public Instruction, the State Board of Education and the California Department of Education. The basis of the lawsuit is safe and decent school facilities, instructional materials, and qualified teachers.

The Instructional Materials Process for the 2019-20 school year is as follows:

1. **Ordering of Instructional Materials:** All instructional materials were ordered based upon 2019-20 enrollment projections, designated schools' responses to Textbook Services inquiries, and in alignment with the one-on-one meetings with Instructional Materials staff. The schedule for the ordering and delivery of instructional materials:

- 2. **Record Keeping:** An excel file is maintained for each order that indicates materials and quantities ordered. Each file is updated after orders are placed. Order files are available upon request. In addition, for the purpose of accountability and maintaining an accurate and current warehouse inventory, individual school instructional material requests are on file. This includes information each time sites pick up materials from the warehouse.
- 3. Instructional Material Survey: Principals met with the Instructional Materials staff to complete the Instructional Materials Survey.
- 4. **Site Leader Meetings:** District staff convened site leader meetings with Williams' schools principals and corresponded via email from March August. The purpose of these meetings was to review the following:
  - Review of site-specific Williams Survey
  - Review of site-specific data about what has been ordered to date
  - Review of updated Projected Enrollment Data
  - Review of language of instruction in bilingual and Dual Language Immersion programs
  - Discussion: Additional needs
- 5. Instructional Materials Request Forms: Beginning in August, principals informed Academics and Instructional Innovation staff of additional textbook needs based upon additional enrollment or lost/damaged materials. Principals submitted an instructional materials request form which indicated the number of additional materials needed.
- 6. **Principal Training for Williams' Schools:** Alameda County Office of Education staff providing training in August for Principals and staff at Williams' schools about how to prepare for the

upcoming Alameda County Office of Education Williams Textbook Audit.

- 7. MOCK-audit: Central office staff members from various departments conducted mock-audits at all Williams' school sites.
- 8. **On-Call Support:** Staff in Academics and Instructional Innovation and the Network Offices worked to ensure that Principals had on-call, one-to-one support throughout the Williams Process.
- 9. **Email Reminders:** Principals were sent email reminders regularly about Williams' deadlines and updates.

### DISCUSSION:

The results of the survey to this date show that all schools have a sufficiency of textbooks and/or instructional materials required by SB 550. The survey will be completed on September 27, 2018.

WHEREAS, the Governing Board of the Oakland Unified School District, in order to comply with the requirements of Education Code 60119, held a public hearing on September 25, 2019, at 5:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter was heard, which is on or before the eighth week of school (between the first day that students attend school and the eighth week from that day) and which did not take place during or immediately following school hours; and

WHEREAS, the Board provided at least ten (10) days notice of the public hearing by posting it in at least three public places within the District that stated the time, place and purpose of the hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Board encouraged participation by parents/guardians, teachers, members of the community, and bargaining unit leaders in the public hearing; and

WHEREAS, information provided at the public hearing detailed the extent to which textbooks and instructional materials were provided to all students, including English learners, in the Oakland Unified School District; and

WHEREAS, the definition of "sufficient textbooks or instructional materials" means that each student, including English learners, has a textbook or instructional materials, or both, to use in class and to take home; and

WHEREAS between the 2008-09 through the 2019-20 fiscal years, the definition of "sufficient textbooks or instructional materials" also means that all students who are enrolled in the same course within the Oakland Unified School District, have standards-aligned textbooks or instructional materials from the same adoption cycle, and

WHEREAS, sufficient textbooks and instructional materials were provided to each student, including English learners that are aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks in the following subjects:

California Education Code Section 60119 requires that the Board hold a public hearing, within the first eight weeks of school, to determine:

(a) whether each pupil in each school of the district has sufficient textbooks or instructional materials or both, that are aligned to the content standards adopted by the state board [of education] in each of the following subjects, as appropriate, that are consistent with the content and cycles of curriculum framework adopted by the state board:

- · Mathematics,
- Science,
- · History-social science,
- English language arts, including the English language development component of an adopted program; and
- (b) whether each pupil enrolled in a world language or health course has sufficient textbooks or instructional materials that are consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum frameworks adopted by the state board for those subjects; and
- (c) the availability of laboratory science equipment as applicable to science laboratory courses offered in grades 9 to 12 inclusive.

Sufficiency of Textbooks or Instructional Materials School Year 2019-20 (Education Code Section 60119 and 5 CCR 9531)

WHEREAS, the Governing Board of the Oakland Unified School District, in order to comply with the requirements of Education Code 60119, held a public hearing on September 25, 2019, at 5:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter was heard, which is on or before the eighth week of school (between the first day that students attend school and the eighth week from that day) and which did not take place during or immediately following school hours; and

WHEREAS, the Board provided at least ten (10) days notice of the public hearing by posting it in at least three public places within the District that stated the time, place and purpose of the hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Board encouraged participation by parents/guardians, teachers, members of the community, and bargaining unit leaders in the public hearing; and

WHEREAS, information provided at the public hearing detailed the extent to which textbooks and instructional materials were provided to all students, including English learners, in the Oakland Unified School District; and

WHEREAS, the definition of "sufficient textbooks or instructional materials" means that each student, including English learners, has a textbook or instructional materials, or both, to use in class and to take home; and

WHEREAS between the 2008-09 through the 2019-20 fiscal years, the definition of "sufficient textbooks or instructional materials" also means that all students who are enrolled in the same course within the Oakland Unified School District, have standards-aligned textbooks or instructional materials from the same adoption cycle, and

WHEREAS, sufficient textbooks and instructional materials were provided to each student, including English learners that are aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks in the following subjects:
