

OUR STRONG CULTURE

Aspire BMA (TK-8)

- 94% Average Daily Attendance
- 93% of families feel welcomed by the school
- 91% of families feel a sense of belonging with the school community
- **88%** of 1st and 2nd graders report that their teacher wants them to do their best
- 84% of 3rd-5th grade students report that their teachers treat people from different cultural backgrounds fairly
- 67% of 6th-8th grade students report that their teachers hold high expectations of them






HISTORICAL ENROLLMENT PATTERNS: BMA






HISTORICAL ENROLLMENT PATTERNS: SPED





FACTORS IN OUR STUDENT ENROLLMENT CHALLENGES

- Oakland is a competitive city for all schools. In 2018-19 there were 121 OUSD district-run and OUSD authorized charter schools.
- About 37% of students in 2018-19 didn't live in Oakland. These were typically families who work in Oakland, and despite their residence elsewhere, are part of the Oakland community.
- Its proximity to Berkeley and changes in neighborhood demographics may influence the future overall representation of students. The Black population dropped by 6.9% and the White population increased by 6.3% between 2011 and 2017.
