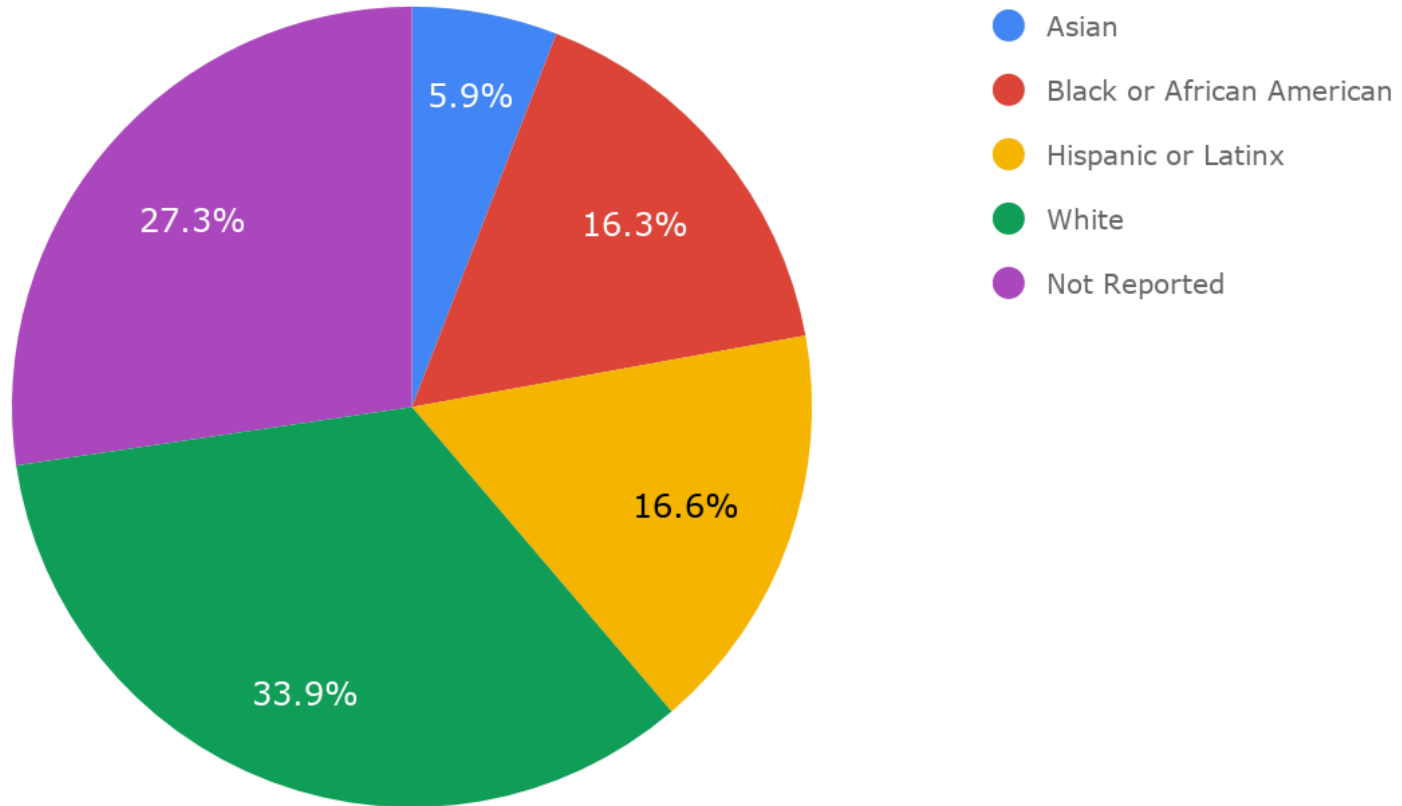

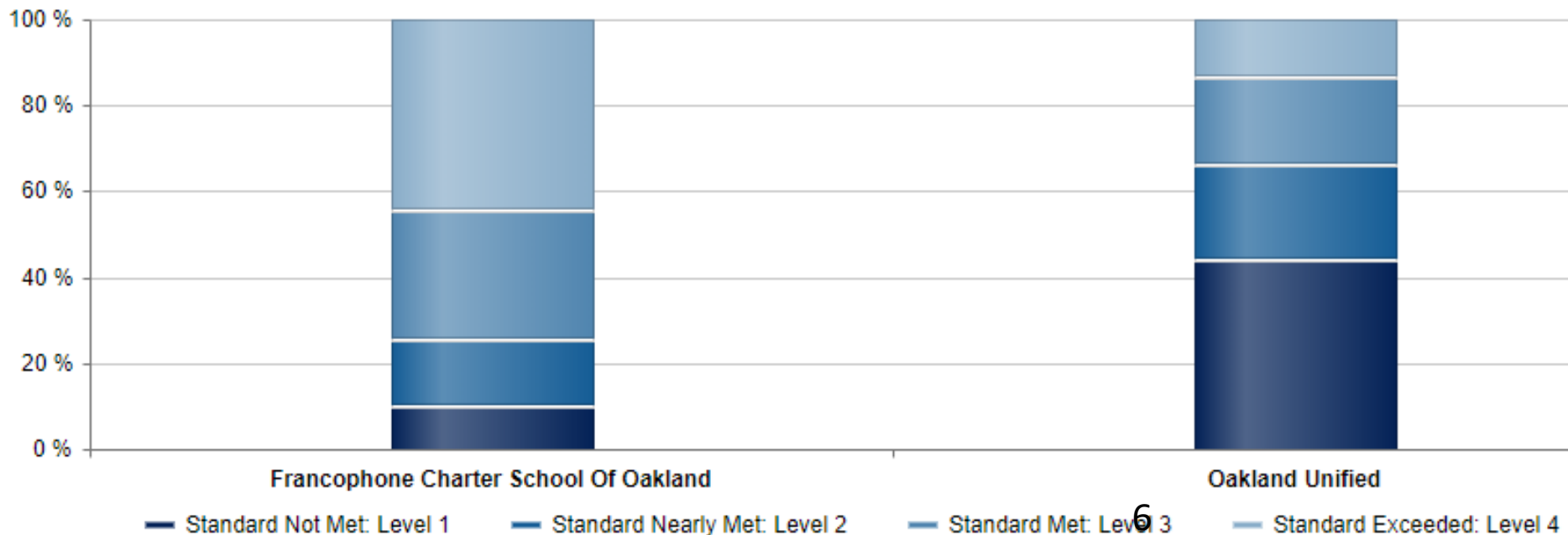

All Grades



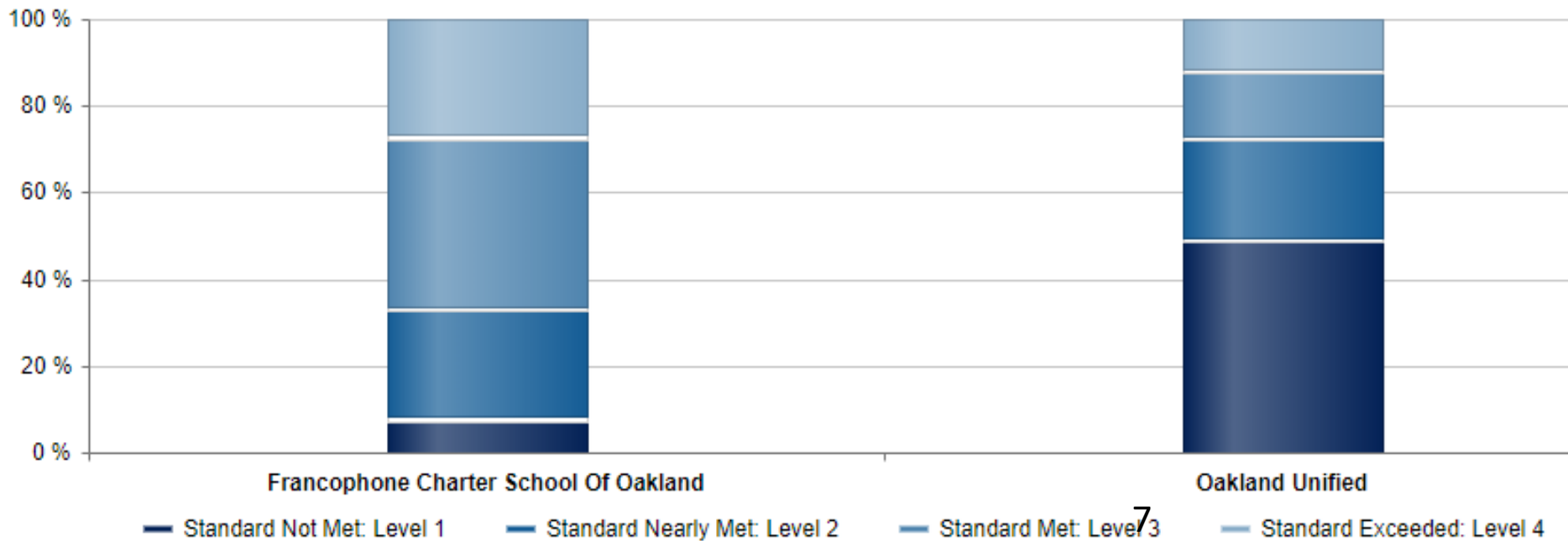

All Grades



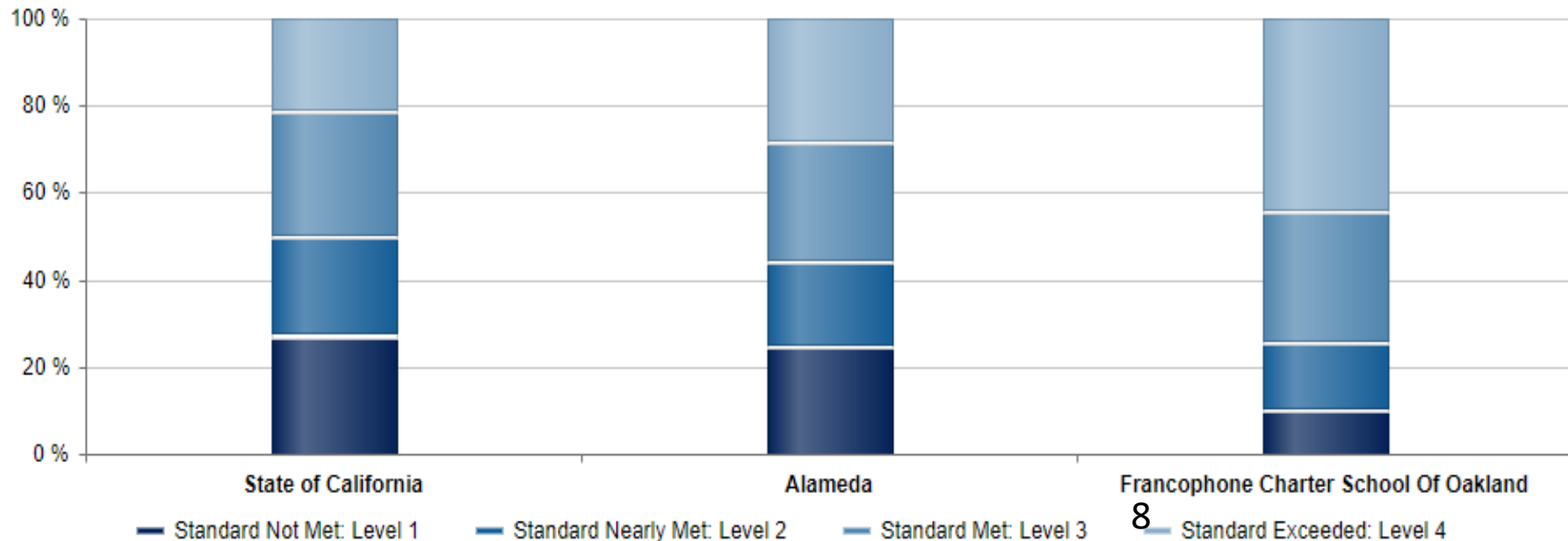
Academic Highlight - State & County Comparisons

All Grades



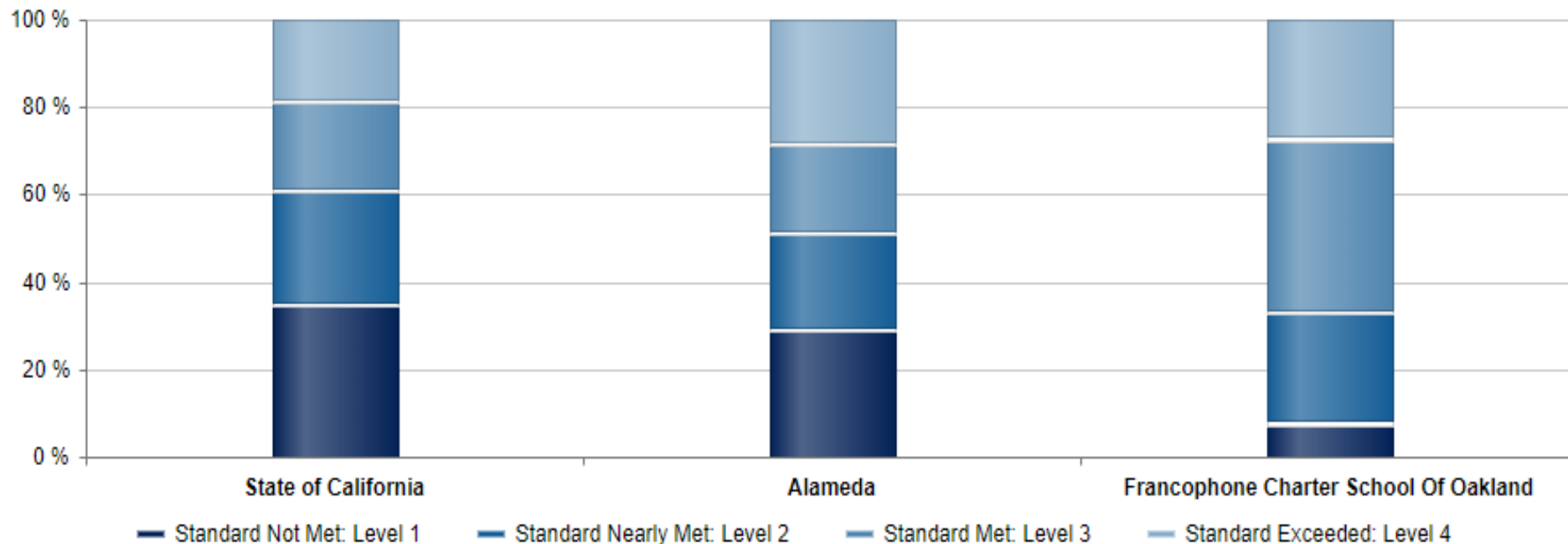

Academic Highlight: Student Achievement in French

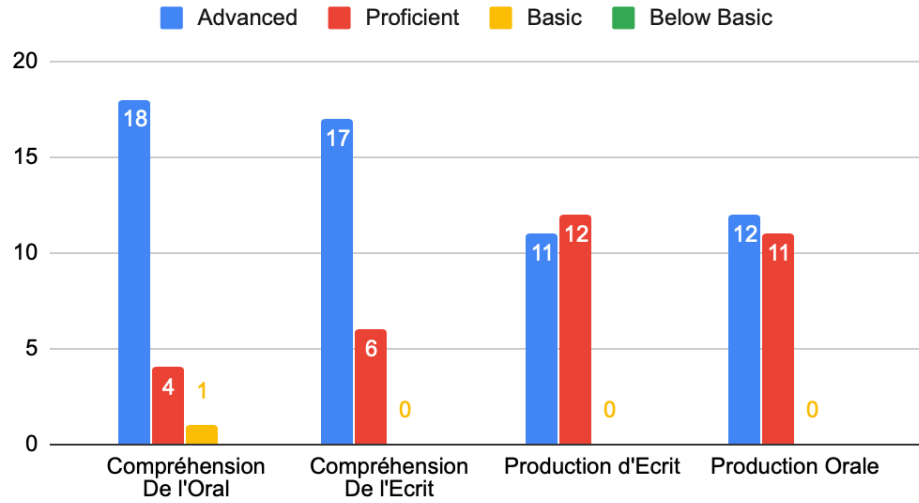
Students at Francophone are prepared to obtain a *Diplôme d'Études en langue française* to show the French they have learned.

Each year, students' skills in oral and written comprehension and expression in French are tested under strict conditions on an exam called the DELF Prim.

100% of FCSO students who took the DELF Prim last spring received the diploma.

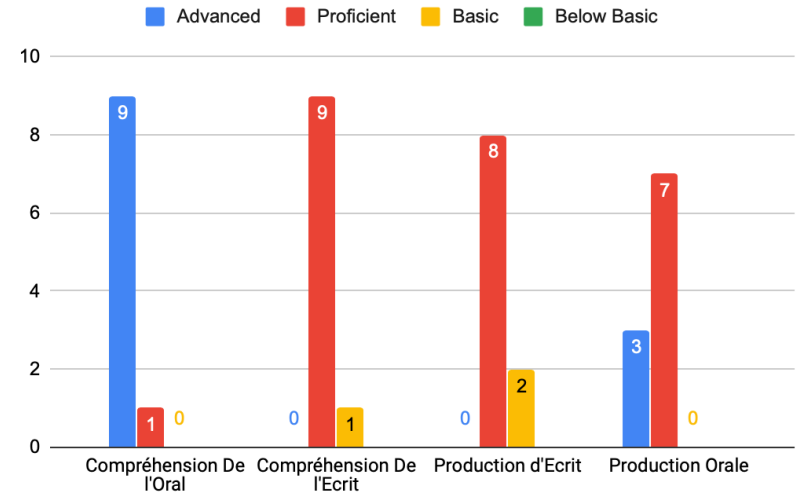

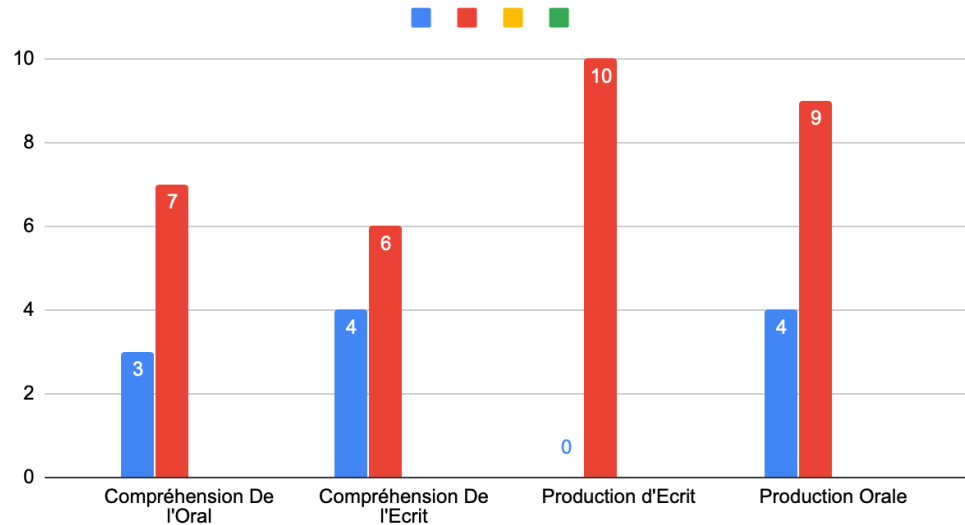

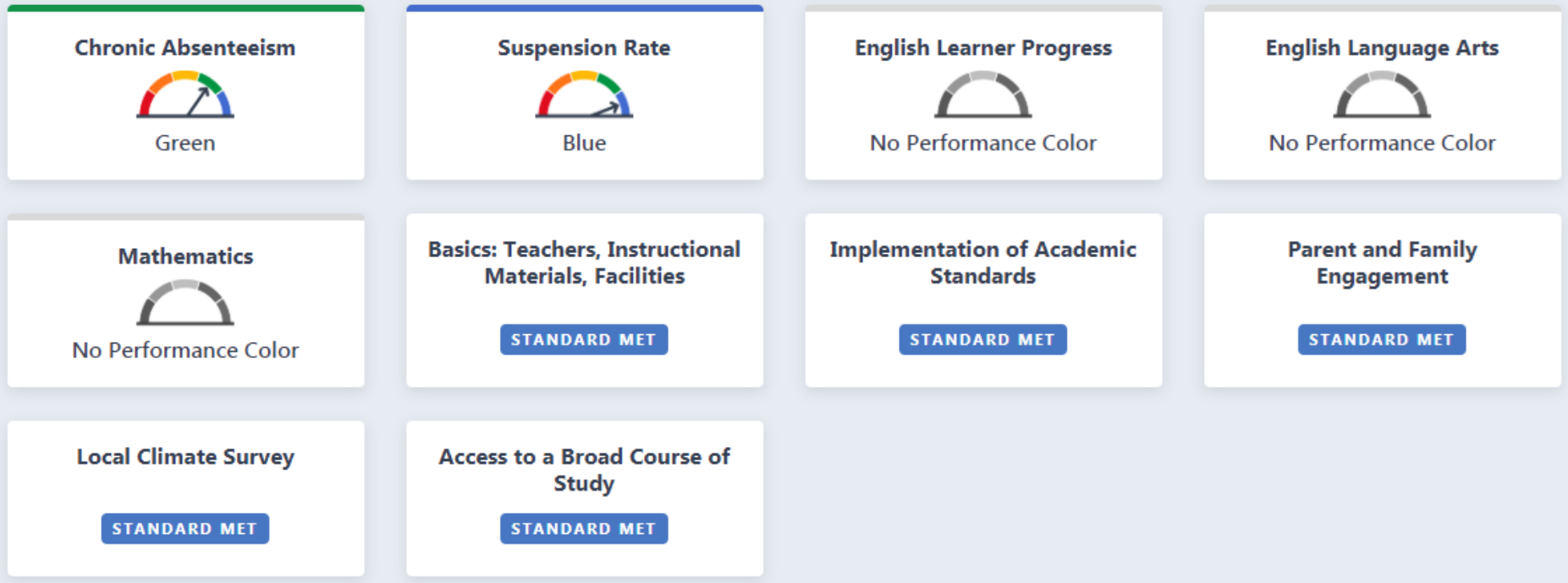

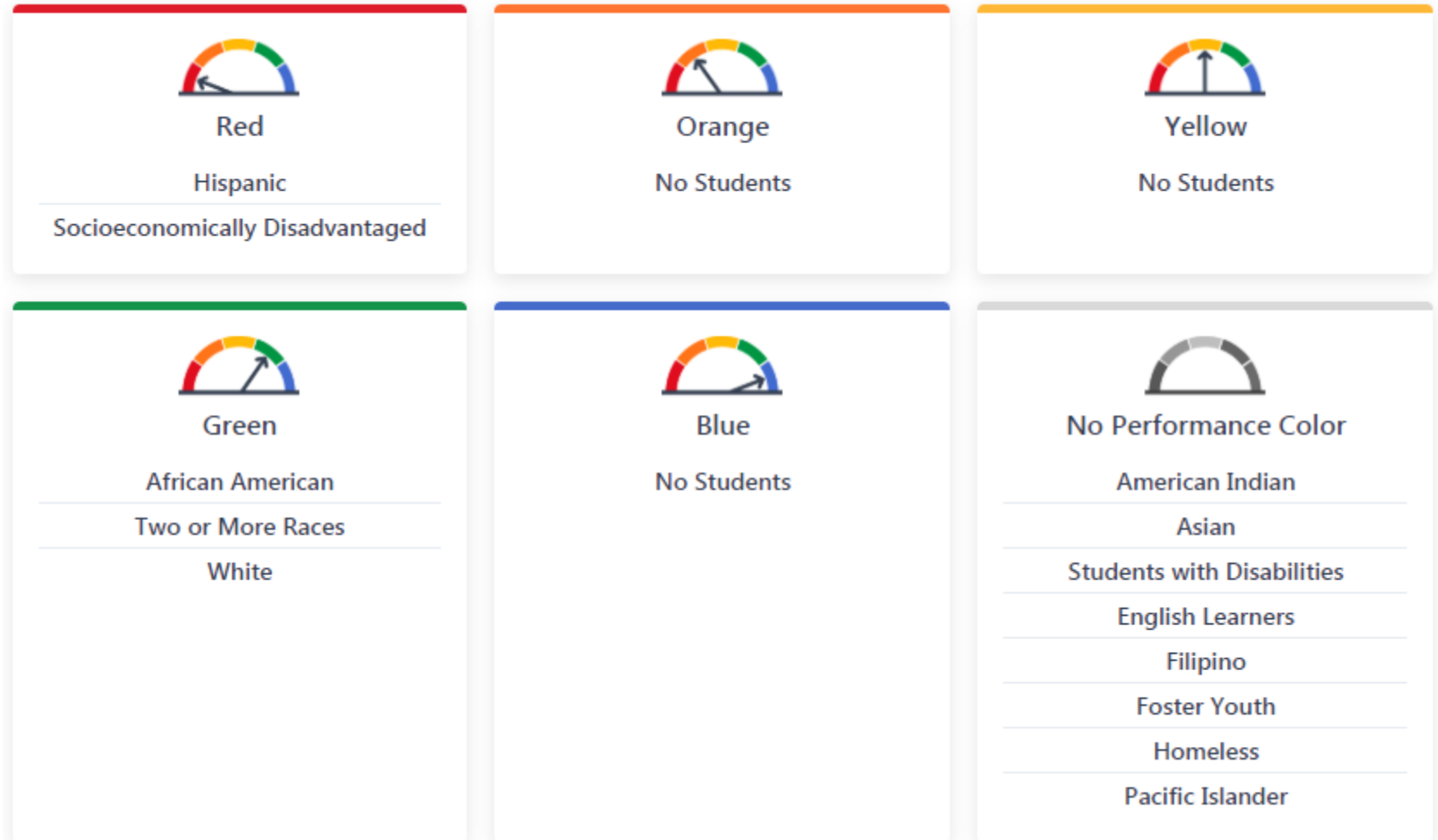

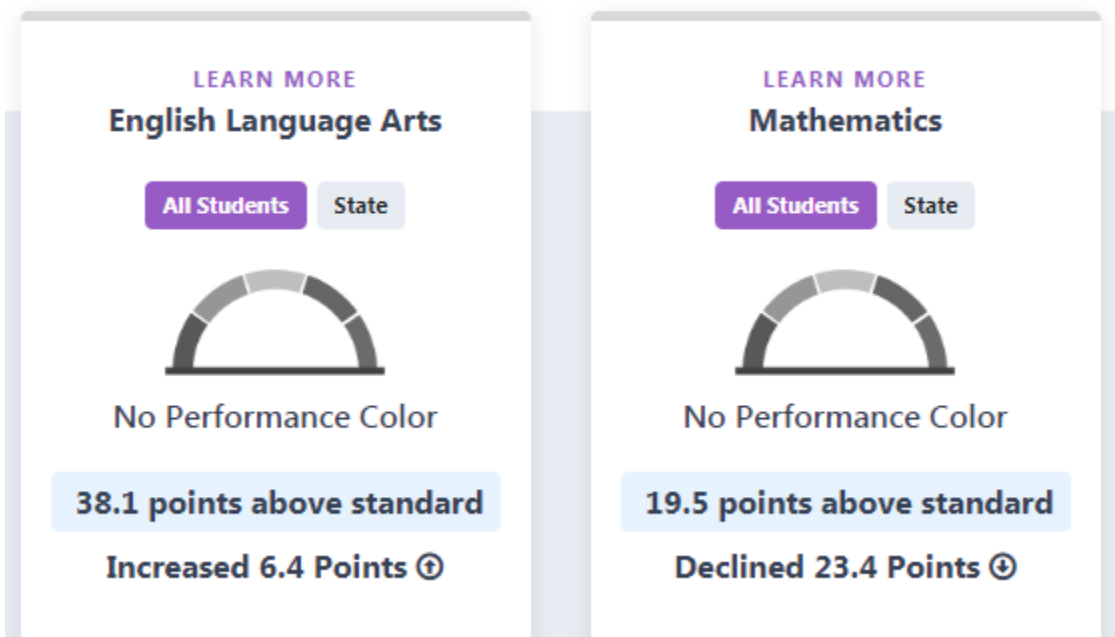
FCSO CA Dashboard Summary



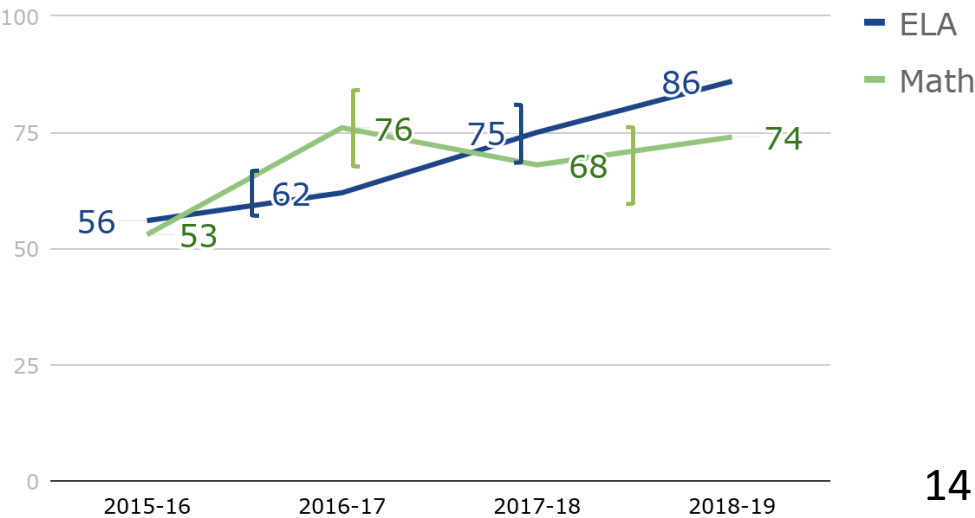
FCSO CA Dashboard Summary - Chronic Absenteeism
