1. Music Program

Programmatic Narrative Based on Rubric

In 2018-19 we had half of the allocation which was used to fund to fund the music position. Since then we have been able to increase access to music to all students (130) each year. This is year 3 of the music program. The music program has had 2 end of year concerts, 2 parent concerts, monthly, monthly assembly concerts. This is the 4th year of the drama program, since then 180 students have been able to access the program. The students have been instrumental to the renovation of the theater space, transforming into a theater performance space. Each year, the drama program and students have been able to produce fall and spring production for the community. Both music and drama programs need a quality performance space. Since we did not have full funding we were using other resources to begin renovations of the theater and bring up to code. The arts committee had planned on using the 2019-20 G1 to complete renovations including audio and stage curtains. However, we were going to have to stagger the project over two years. The \$11,103.65 in carry over will allow for the whole curtain project to be completed this year.
