The field trips require funding for admission and transportation.

Positive Attendance & Behavior Incentives: Reward and incentive items that motivate middle school students are diverse. After surveying the students about what incentives they may like, they included dances with a DJ & food, fun "cool" assemblies, and other programs that require funding.
