Our stakeholders have identified Personalized Learning Supports and Building a Rigorous Academic Core as areas of strength, and they also agree with the commission that WBL is a clear area of growth. We plan to use Measure N funds to hire a Linked Learning coordinator who can build and run a clearly articulated and equitable WBL program. We have established an industry advisory board and plan to expand our partnership with industry and higher education. Our recent shift in site leadership has helped us create more shared ownership of the Linked Learning Pathway and build staff understanding and engagement. We appreciate the feedback and guidance shared by the Measure N commission and our consultant, Patricia Clark. We are taking the steps needed to advance our Linked Learning approach to ensure that all of our students have equitable access to all pieces of our pathway and emerge ready to thrive in college and career.
