Pathway Vision	The OSA Fashion Design pathway provides comprehensive artistic and technical training for aspiring young designers. A diverse curriculum is offered for students in grades 9th – 12th in the fundamentals of fashion, costume design, and production. Fashion Design students are responsible for costuming at least two to five OSA productions a year and students study clothing construction, draping, millinery, FX makeup, costume history, and fashion illustration. To ensure that students are prepared for future study and careers in fashion, there is a strong emphasis on being able to communicate design ideas and preparing a portfolio presentation. The Fashion Design pathway teaches students that self motivation, problem solving and work ethic are the keys to success in the arts and in life. The goal is to inspire students to continue their craft at design colleges both domestically and internationally, and to excel in professional work environments as innovative designers, technicians and artisans.
