Ratification by the Board of Education of President of Board's appointment of William Masterson to the Measure G Parcel Tax Independent Citizens Oversight Committee, effective February 1, 2020, for term ending January 31, 2022.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

The duties of the Measure G Committee, as defined by Board Bylaw 9131, is to inform the public concerning the expenditure of parcel tax revenues and to review and report on the proper expenditure of taxpayers' money generated by the 2009 Measure G parcel tax.

The Measure G Committee is composed of seven members, with staggered terms, appointed pursuant to membership criteria established by Board Bylaw 9131, with an individual's terms of appointment limited to a maximum of three two-year consecutive terms or the fulfillment of unexpired terms thereof.

There currently exists one vacancy and there will be two additional vacancies on the Measure G Committee as of February 1, 2020.

I, pursuant to Board Bylaw 9131, hereby nominate William Masterson, as a member of Measure G Committee, and recommend ratification of his appointment.
