Preschool.

Background and Discussion

This Resolution is required as a provision of the SELPA Local Plan for Oakland Unified School District SELPA. The OUSD SELPA has the responsibility to adopt a plan (in accordance with California Education Code 56200) to assure that special education and services for all eligible individuals with disabilities residing in the geographic area served by OUSD SELPA are delivered. Specific resolutions are called for as a part of that plan that do not currently exist within OUSD Board Policy. SELPA policy requires that the body governing OUSD SELPA is the Oakland Unified Board of Education, which must adopt SELPA policies when additions or adaptations become necessary.

The District must serve eligible students from birth to age three and support their transition to preschool under the provisions of Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA). Children participating in early intervention programs under IDEA, Part C, and who will participate in preschool programs, experience

a smooth and effective transition to preschool programs in a manner consistent with 20 USC Section 1437(a)(9). The transition process shall begin

prior to the child's third birthday.

Adopting and Complying With Requirements for Specific Resolutions that are Necessary for the Special Education Local Plan Area's ("SELPA") Policy Regarding Serving Eligible Students from Birth to Age Three and Supporting Their Transition to Preschool

**WHEREAS,** Education Code section 56195.5 prescribes that the district governing board shall have authority over the programs it directly maintains, consistent with the local plan submitted pursuant to 56195.1; and

WHEREAS, Oakland Unified School District ("OUSD") is a single-district Special Education Local Plan Area ("SELPA"); and

WHEREAS, Oakland Unified School District's Governing Board ("Board") has authority over the programs provided through the OUSD SELPA; and

**WHEREAS,** pursuant to Education Code section 56195, the OUSD SELPA has the responsibility to adopt a plan in accordance with Education Code section 56200 to assure that special education and services for all individuals residing in the geographical area served by the OUSD SELPA are delivered; and

WHEREAS, policies governing OUSD SELPA shall be adopted by the Board; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code section 56122 and 56205(a), OUSD SELPA Local Plan must ensure conformity with Title 20 United States Code (USC) and Title 34 Code of Federal Regulations Section 300.201 and identify whether or not for each of 23 areas the SELPA has a specific written policy or a specific board adopted resolution where the policy can be found,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Board acknowledges that the OUSD SELPA must serve eligible students from birth to age three and support their transition to preschool under the provisions of Individuals with Disabilities Education Act ("IDEA");

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the Board hereby adopts the following SELPA policy regarding students eligible from birth to age three: "Children participating in early intervention programs under IDEA, Part C, and who will participate in preschool programs, experience a smooth and effective transition to preschool programs in a manner consistent with 20 *USC* Section 1437(a)(9). The transition process shall begin prior to the child's third birthday."
