PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Fremont High School New School Construction includes:

Increment 1: New school entry and parking lot.

Increment 2: New 2-story Pre-Fabricated 12 classroom building.

Increment 3: Renovating existing building (Building B) to house spaces for Career Technical Education pathways.

Increment 4: Extension of new parking lot. New regulated football field, gymnasium with wellness center inside.

UPDATE

Construction - Increment 2. New 2-story Building

2-way communication final inspections are on-going. Pathway has been provided to safely enter Frog bldg. while Inc. 3 site work continues.

Construction - Increment 3. Building B Renovation

Flooring install is nearly complete. Courtyard site work landscaping continues. Canopy install continues. Ceiling tile install continues. Mechanical and electrical trim continue.

Construction - Increment 4. Gymnasium, Football Stadium and Wellness Clinic

Field work continues. Gymnasium floor install and striping are complete. Coach Allamanno's name has been included on the gymnasium floor. Interior bleacher install continues. Mural install will begin in October . Site work and landscaping continue.
