Restorative Justice across all grades with a focus to eliminate disproportionate discipline data for African American students and students with disabilities.

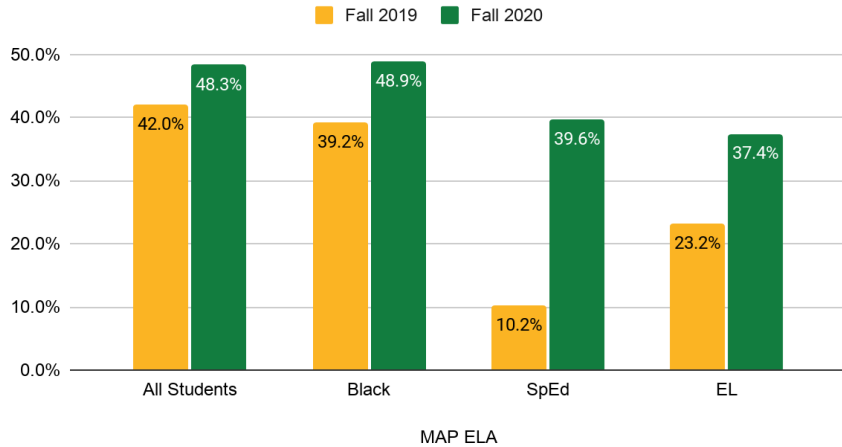
Attendance Playbook that ensures every office manager, dean of students, and family engagement coordinator is supporting chronically absent students and their families.



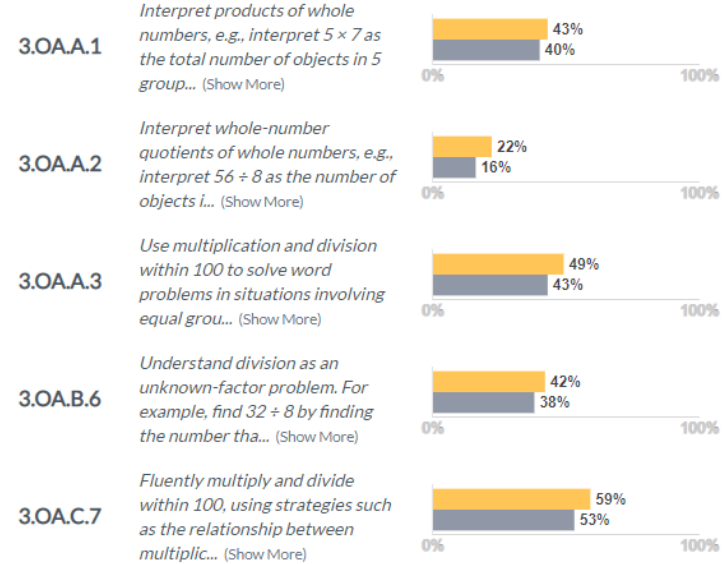
