Material Revisions - Overview

Background:

- Lighthouse Community Public Schools submitted a material revision to the the Lighthouse K-8 charter when it submitted its charters on 10/1/20.
- These revisions support our commitment to serving East Oakland's most vulnerable student population.

Changes:

- Increasing the enrollment cap from 490 to 515 students in grades K 8
- Reduce staff preference from 5% to 2.5% (priority 2/8)
- Prioritize students who are homeless/unsheltered (priority 3/8)



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Proposed Material Revisions - Lottery Priority

- A sibling to a current student in either the K 8 Lighthouse Community Charter School and/or the 9 12 Lighthouse Community Charter School
- Not to exceed 2.5% of the total enrollment; A child of school faculty, staff, board
- Students who are homeless/unsheltered during the time of enrollment or who become unsheltered while on the waiting list
- Students who are currently enrolled in or who reside within the elementary school attendance area in which Lighthouse is located
- Students living in the 94621 or 94603 zip code
- A sibling of a Lighthouse alum.
- Other prospective students residing within OUSD boundaries: as required by Education Code Section 47605(d)(2)(B)
- All other applicants
