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Summarizing the Local Control Funding Formula

- The primary funding for school districts is the Local Control Funding Formula
 - 2020-21 LCFF \$382 M
 - 58% \$220M is allocated and spent at school sites
 - 20% \$78M is allocated to Contributions
 - 21% \$78.5M Remains for Academic, General & Admin Exp
 - 1% \$5.5M for the District's Loan Payment
 - This is only the UnRestricted Funding
 - \$6M of Measure G Funding is supporting Base Programming
