Subject CCEE Systemic Instructional Review (SIR) Support

Action Discussion

Background OUSD met the criteria for a systemic instructional review and support process designed to assist us on the path to improvement in pupil achievement. Our school district meets the criteria established pursuant to subdivision (g) of Section 52064.5 (CA School Dashboard) whereby three or more pupil groups identified pursuant to Section 52052 did not make progress based on the CA School Dashboard. Those student groups include African American, English learners, and students experiencing homelessness.

- The CCEE in partnership with the Alameda County Office of Education (ACOE) presented to the OUSD board on August 26th, 2020 on the purpose of the OUSD SIR and the estimated timeline.

Discussion The [OUSD SIR report](#) and the [executive summary](#) were completed at the end of January 2021. From the SIR recommendations OUSD, ACOE and CCEE will work collaboratively to prioritize the actions within the SIR report, establish a plan of action to implement them, and engage in progress monitoring activities to ensure improvement.
