Subject Resolution No. 2021-0147 Declaring Oakland School Police Department Property Obsolete, Surplus and Authorizing Destruction Thereof

Action Requested Approval by the Board of Education of Resolution 2021-0147 Declaring Oakland School Police Department Property Obsolete, Surplus and Authorizing Destruction Thereof.

Discussion On June 24, 2020, the Board of Education passed Resolution No. 1920-0260- George Floyd Resolution to Eliminate the Oakland Schools Police Department, which directed the Superintendent to take the steps necessary to eliminate the Oakland Schools Police Department prior to January 1, 2021 or as soon thereafter as legally permissible and to ensure that the District will eliminate the sworn law enforcement employees of the Oakland School Police Department.

Following the December 9, 2020, approval of Resolution 2021-0127- George Floyd District Safety Plan (Phase I) that identified the steps necessary to eliminate the Oakland Schools Police Department by January 1, 2021 or as soon thereafter as legally permissible, the District will no longer have the Oakland Schools Police Department ("OSPD"). Therefore, firearms, body cameras, police radios, and pepper spray that were the property of OSPD are now obsolete. Such items be declared obsolete, surplus and destroyed.

Recommendation Approval by the Board of Education of Resolution 2021-0147 Declaring Oakland School Police Department Property Obsolete, Surplus and Authorizing Destruction Thereof.

Fiscal Impact Destruction of the property is at no cost to the District.

**Declaring Oakland Schools Police Department Property Obsolete, Surplus, and
Authorizing Destruction Thereof**

WHEREAS, on June 24, 2020, the Board of Education passed Resolution No. 1920-0260- George Floyd Resolution to Eliminate the Oakland Schools Police Department, which directed the Superintendent to take the steps necessary to eliminate the Oakland Schools Police Department prior to January 1, 2021 or as soon thereafter as legally permissible and to ensure that the District will eliminate the sworn law enforcement employees of the Oakland School Police Department; and

WHEREAS, on December 9, 2020, the Board of Education passed Resolution 2021-0127- George Floyd District Safety Plan (Phase I) that identified the steps necessary to eliminate the Oakland Schools Police Department by January 1, 2021 or as soon thereafter as legally permissible; and

WHEREAS, the District will no longer employ law enforcement; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education has received a list of Oakland Schools Police Department property – i.e. firearms, body cameras, police radios, and pepper spray listed in Exhibit A deemed not for school purposes and not suitable for school use; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent that the firearms, body cameras, police radios, and pepper spray are destroyed;

WHEREAS, it is recommended that the Board declare said property listed in Exhibit “A” surplus and commissioned to be destroyed; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board hereby declares said property listed in attached Exhibit “A” not to be required for school purposes and not suitable for school use; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board hereby authorized disposal of each item listed in attached Exhibit “A” by destruction.


