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






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Measure N: Probationary Status Reserve













Potential Recommendation

- Once Probationary schools exit probationary status, schools will receive full funding at \$850 per pupil through year 10 (2024-2025) of the parcel tax
- They are eligible to access their reserve funding in year 11 (2025-2026) and must submit a
 Measure N Education Plan to the Measure N Commission for approval in year 10 (2024-2025)
 on how they will use the funds in year 11
