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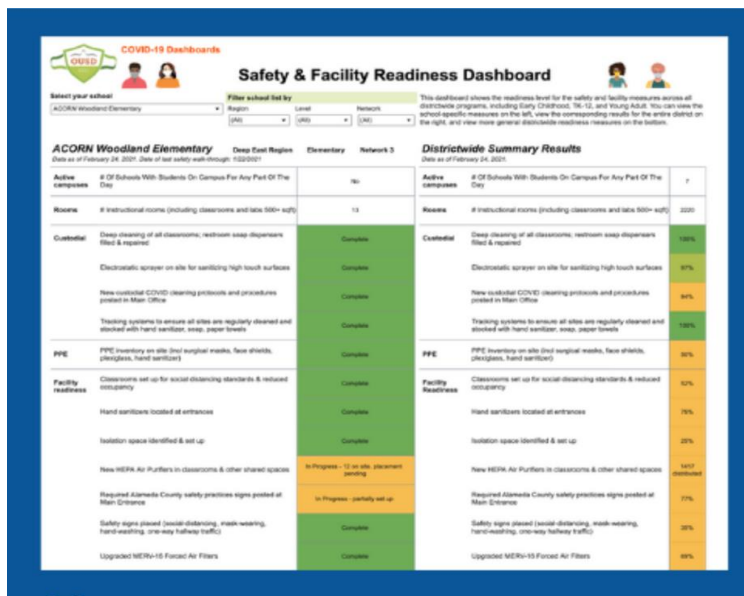

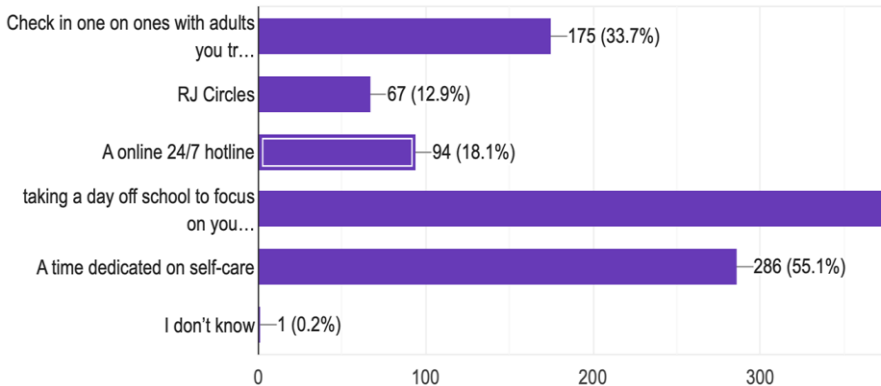


# Student Survey Results

## (Feedback for next year support & learning plan)

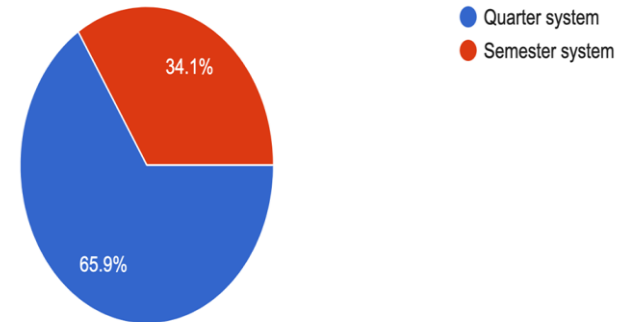
How can OUSD help your mental health? (Like services and resources)


