 Gregory Houchins is the Acting Head Custodian for the LaEscuelita Complex and has served the District for 7 years



 - "Dan has been instrumental to our district as he has led a huge amount of technology projects over time which moved our network from barely working to a highly functioning system, usable for education . . . "


