

Weekly % of COVID-19 Cohort Cases





Vaccine Outreach

Partnership with Alameda County

- Over 20,000 people vaccinated through vaccine clinic at Fremont High School
- 250+ Codes provides to 16+ year old students and their families for Pfizer at the Coliseum

Vaccine Outreach Training

- Training for 75+ parents to make call/help make appointments for OUSD families
- 282 students trained through Life Academy vaccine teach-in

High School Summer Learning

School counselors will recommend students that need Academic Recovery this summer to stay on track for graduation.

High School Programs

- As school counselors recommend students for credit recovery, families receive a mobile invitation to register.
- Families will receive final confirmation from their summer program over the next few weeks.
- High School students/families should contact their school counselor to see if they are recommended to attend.
- Schools can also enroll families over the phone.







Community Summer Programs

Families can go to www.inplay.org/r/oakland to learn of opportunities from City of Oakland and other community organizations.

Based on Feedback from ACC:

- We are supporting community organizations across the city to increase access and to support outreach to fill all available enrollment slots, especially those that offer:
 - outdoor enrichment activities
 - mental health support for teens
 - youth employment opportunities
 - college counseling







Fall Secondary In-person Learning Updates

Options

In-person Instruction

- We are planning for full, inperson instruction, 5 days a week, for all students.
- The first day of school is August
 9, 2021 (pending Board of Education approval)
- Middle and high schools will operate on a semester model.

Distance Learning Option

Still working on details, the following seems clear:

- Families will more than likely have to unenroll from their current school to enroll in a distance-only option. Students cannot be enrolled in more than one school at a time.
- Families can opt back into in-person learning at set times.
- Families who opt into distance learning are not guaranteed a spot back at their previous school

Families will not have to make a binding decision until later this summer.

- In July, families who want to enroll in a distance learning option will have to fill out a form for the fall.














Highlights from School Sites




Student Vaccine Ambassadors at Life Academy
