Subject Comprehensive Local Needs Assessment: Career Technical Education (CTE) Advisory Committee Approval of CTE Program Priorities for 2021-22

Ask of the Committee Approval of priorities for Career Technical Education under Perkins V for 2021-22.

Background The Perkins Act requires LEA's to hold a district-wide CTE Advisory Committee meeting, also known as Stakeholder Engagement meeting, that meets at least once annually to review evaluative data that enables identification of achievement gaps in Career Technical Education.

Discussion The CTE Advisory Committee will review participation and achievement data for students in CTE programs. Participation and achievement will be analyzed by race and gender for pathways in Engineering & Design and Design, Visual & Media Arts. These pathways were chosen because they represent a significant number of student participants and span multiple high schools across the district.

CTE teachers participated in a CTE program evaluation on March 31, 2021. Observations and proposed strategies to address participation and achievement gaps were developed by CTE teachers and informed the proposed strategies drafted by the High School Linked Learning Office.

The CTE Advisory Committee will give review the proposed strategies drafted by the High School Linked Learning Office, may propose additional or different strategies, and will vote to approve or reject the strategies. These strategies will be represented in the application the High School Linked Learning staff submits to the CA Department of Education for Perkins funding on May 15, 2021.

Fiscal Impact Perkins funding is approximately \$450,000 annually and is awarded by application to the CA Department of Education.
