- 1. Parent liaisons and stipended parents for parent education and to support partnerships with families
- 2. Anti-bias/discrimination training that includes anti-ableism; better support for students with emotional disabilities and needs.
- Increased mental health support for all students: e.g. counselors, nurses, & long-term alliances with Mental Health providers
- 4. Literacy intervention

- 5. Manage money well and make sure it goes to the schools/students. Include students and parents in oversight.
- 6. Address disproportionality rates of Black students with disabilities being suspended
- 7. PD around RJ work and trauma informed practice and response for all staff (incl. cafeteria, custodial, security, etc.)
- 8. Additional support for technology to be used to better effect, including support for families to better use technology (especially for communication)

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- 10. Expand and supporting Social Emotional activities and spaces to release and process trauma (including arts)
- 11. Individualized small group instruction (including ELD and literacy, and special support for ELLs with IEPs)

- 12. SIPPS/literacy training for all teachers at all grade levels for providing intervention; ensure that 9-12th grade students receive literacy intervention
- 13. Multilingual community/family engagement positions at all schools sites
- 14. Math Intervention at all levels (e.g. Blueprint Math)
