ACC organizes campaigns and activities to serve the assessed needs of our constituents; including addressing internalized, interpersonal, and institutional oppression in our daily lives and the daily functioning of our schools and working towards solutions.

Meaningful Student Engagement



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The MSE collaborative is a group of organizations and individuals that work in partnership with the school district to engage, uplift, and empower students, parents, and families by lifting student voice, needs, and solutions. The collaborative came out of the *Organize Da Bay* movement (2006), and continues that legacy today.

2020-2021 Key Accomplishments



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- The All City Council (ACC) Governing Board participated in a peer-led (ACC alumni) annual summer on-boarding and leadership institute including training on representative leadership, individual and collective leadership skills.
- Oakland youth vote (Measure QQ) successfully passed during the November 2020 ballot
- Mental Health Resolution w/ Jessica
- ACC hosted 4 virtual high school meetings & 5 virtual middle school meetings (including our Annual Youth Action Summit & our Annual Middle School Peer Resource & Ethnic Studies Conference) to engage with OUSD students
 - Community Building
 - Civic Engagement on Oakland Youth Vote (OYV)
 - Leadership skill development
 - Feedback on Re-opening & Hybrid planning
- ACC Governing Board participation in: COVID 19 Youth Prevention Campaign, Central Kitchen Student Advisory Committee, OUSD Sanctuary Task Force, High School Literacy Project, Safety Plan Design Team, PSAC, and



ACC in the Oakland Youth Vote Coalition

- On May 19th 2020, Oakland City Council voted UNANIMOUSLY to include youth vote on the November 2020 ballot to allow 16 and 17 years olds the right to vote in school board elections
 - ACC participated in broader coalition of youth organizations to ensure oakland youth vote was successfully passed by phone banking to Oakland Voters and helping fundraise -
 - Through our campaign launch event we were able to fundraise 108K, engage 5.5K voters, and...
 - OAKLAND YOUTH VOTE PASSED 68% !!

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LCAP Student Engagement

- LCAP student advisors are elected and represent at the All City Council Student Union HS meetings. Two students from OUSD schools attend all LCAP PSAC meetings and serve as full voting members.
- LCAP students have met with budget officers from the OUSD head office as well as community organizations and city government to create and present reports about the state of student voice and our budget priorities.
- LCAP plan for the 2021-24 school year has been drafted
- COVID relief funds - Young folks would like to see these funds go toward restorative justice, credit recovery, mental support such as counselors, and essentials to stay clean when folks go back to in person school.
