Subject OUSD Gateway to College at Laney College: California Department of Education - Dashboard Alternative School Status (DASS) Eligibility Certification

Ask of the Board Approval by the Board of Education of the California Department of Education (CDE) Dashboard Alternative School Status Eligibility Certification Oakland International High School (OIHS) for the period of July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2024, at no cost to the District.

Background California Education Code (EC) Section 52052(d) requires the State Superintendent of Public Instruction, with the approval of the State Board of Education (SBE), to develop an alternative accountability system for community day schools and alternative schools serving high-risk pupils, including continuation schools and eligible alternative schools of choice. As a result, the CDE developed the Dashboard Alternative School Status (DASS) program to replace the previously administered Alternative School Accountability Model (ASAM) to hold alternative schools and alternative schools of choice accountable using modified methods of measurement for accountability indicators. The alternative school dashboard launched in Fall 2018.

EC Section 52052(d) automatically qualifies Continuation and Community Day schools with an alternative status and these schools will automatically be placed in DASS. Alternative Schools of Choice having an unduplicated count of at least 70 percent of the school's total enrollment (upon first entry to the school) comprised of high-risk student groups are eligible for DASS and must re-apply for alternative status to participate in DASS. OIHS is an Alternative School of Choice and meets the eligibility requirements for DASS.

Discussion Approval by the Board of Education of the California Department of Education (CDE) Dashboard Alternative School Status Eligibility Certification for Oakland International High School for the period of July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2024.


