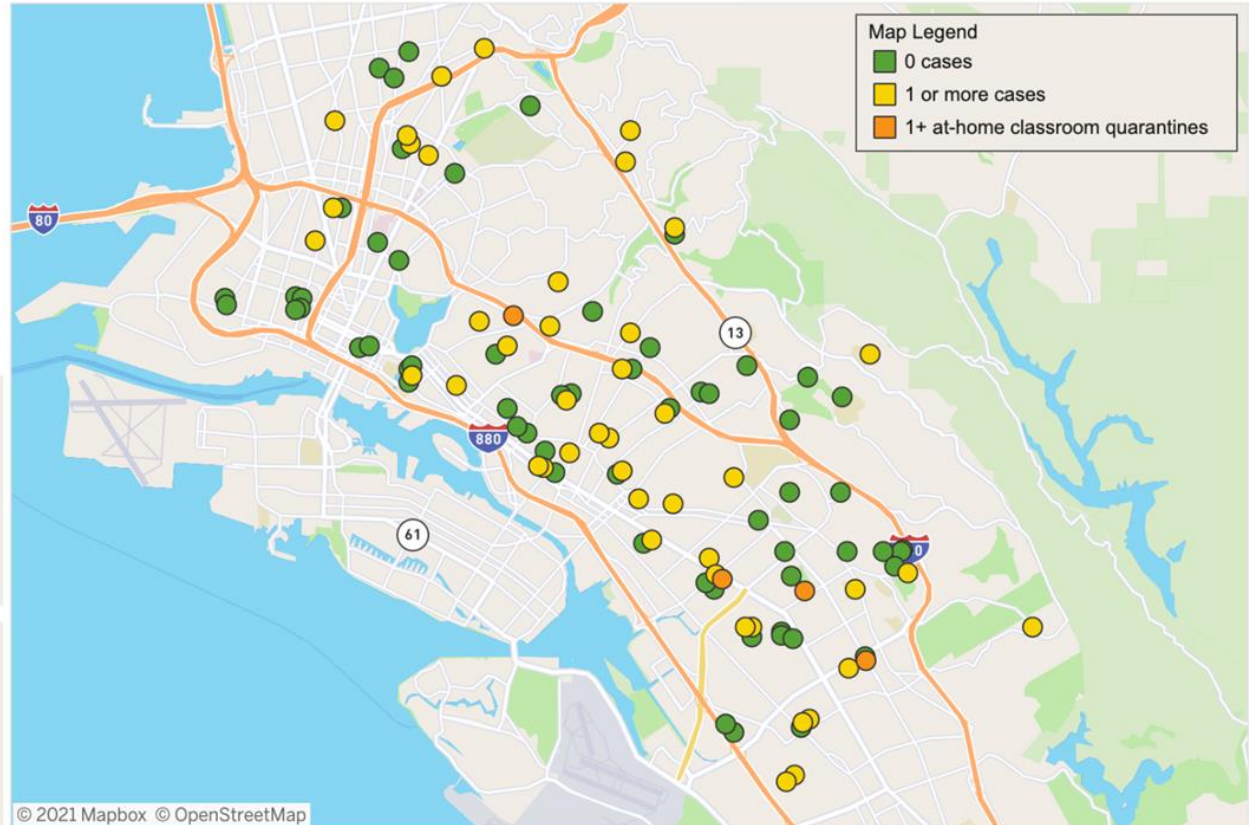

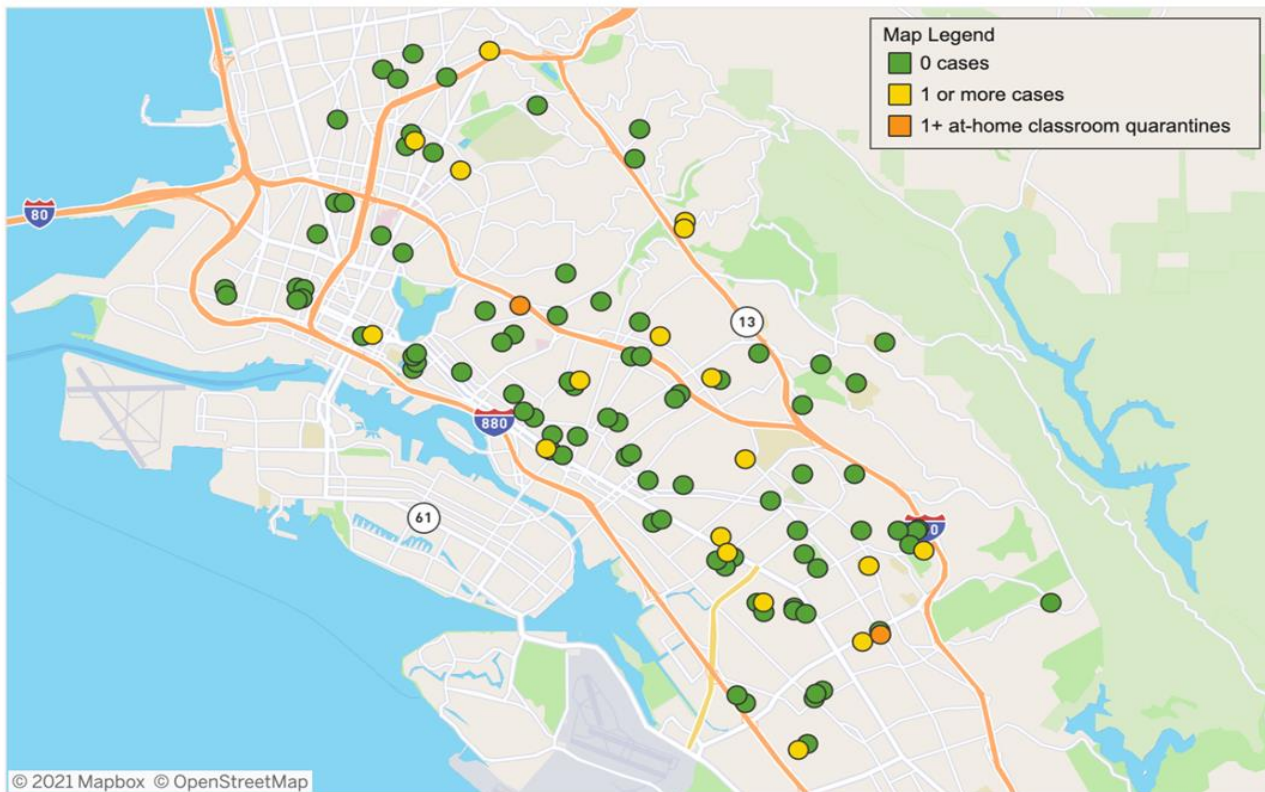

High School Readiness

8th Grade High School Readiness

High School readiness measures the degree to which 8th grade students are prepared for the rigor and expectations of high school. The combination of attendance, behavior, and course grades is used to gauge middle school students' likelihood to succeed in high school.

A student is considered on track to being "High School Ready" when ALL of the following requirements have been met at the end of the first semester in 8th grade:

1. Total weighted GPA of 2.5 or better
2. School attendance 96% or better
3. No "Ds" or "Fs" in their core English and Math course grades in 8th grade
4. No suspensions in 8th grade
