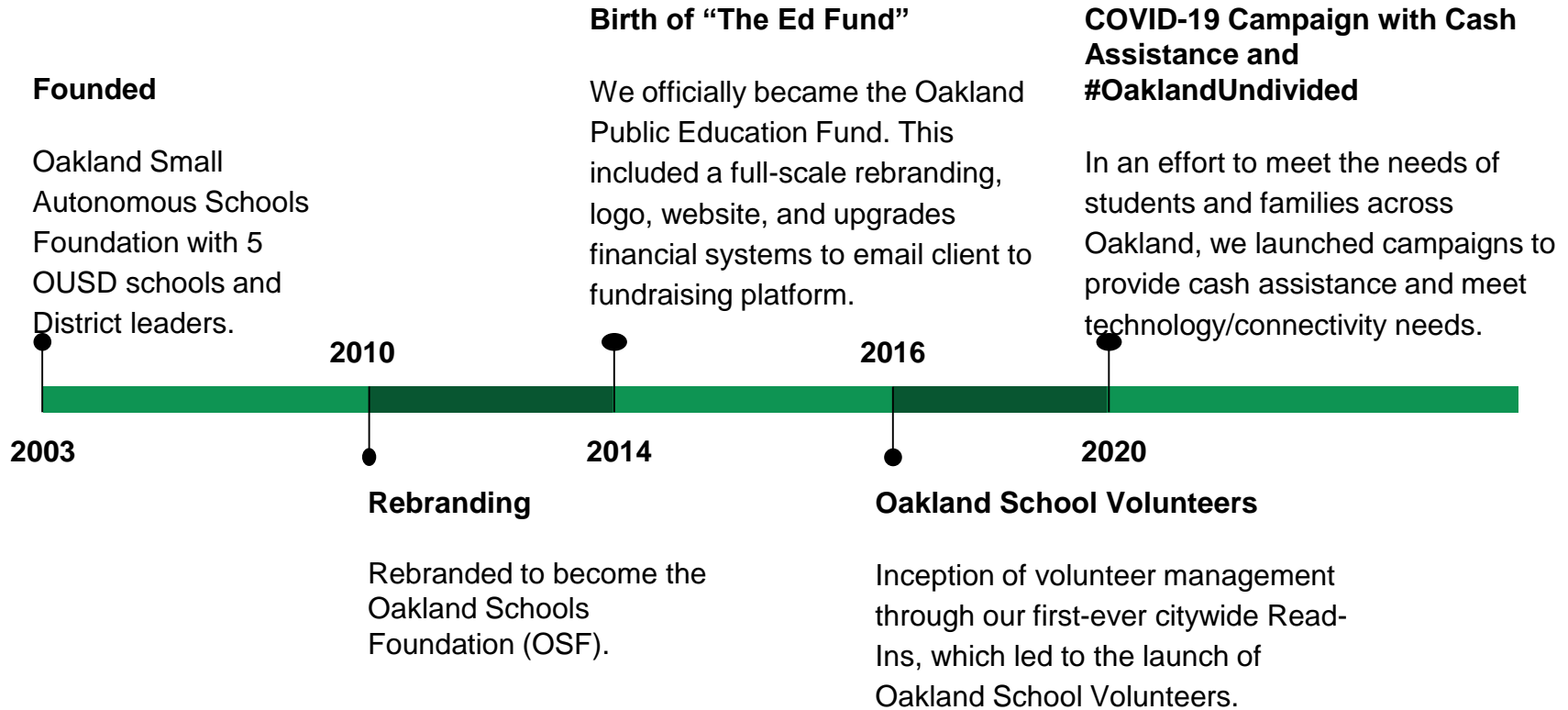

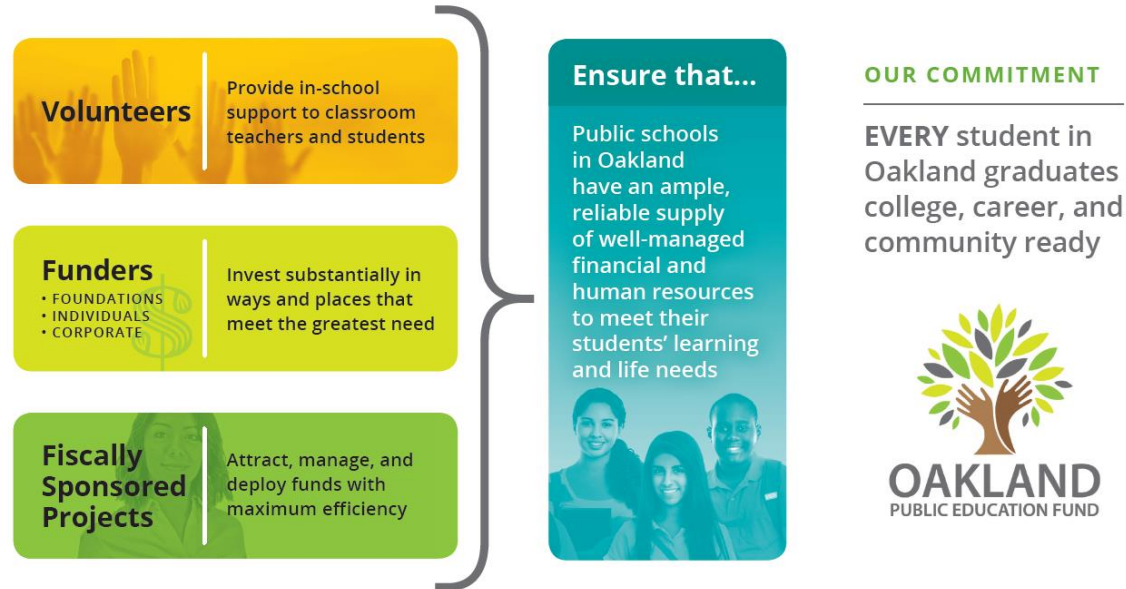

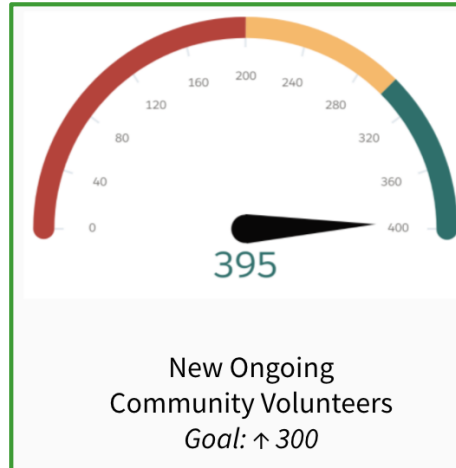
The Ed Fund is the only organization in Oakland dedicated to raising resources for all Oakland Public Schools.



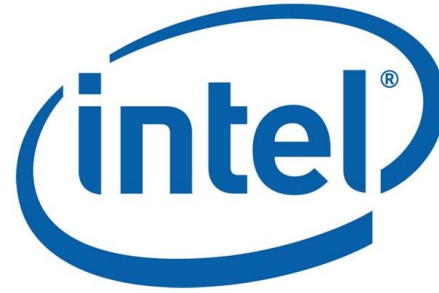
Fiscally Sponsored Projects

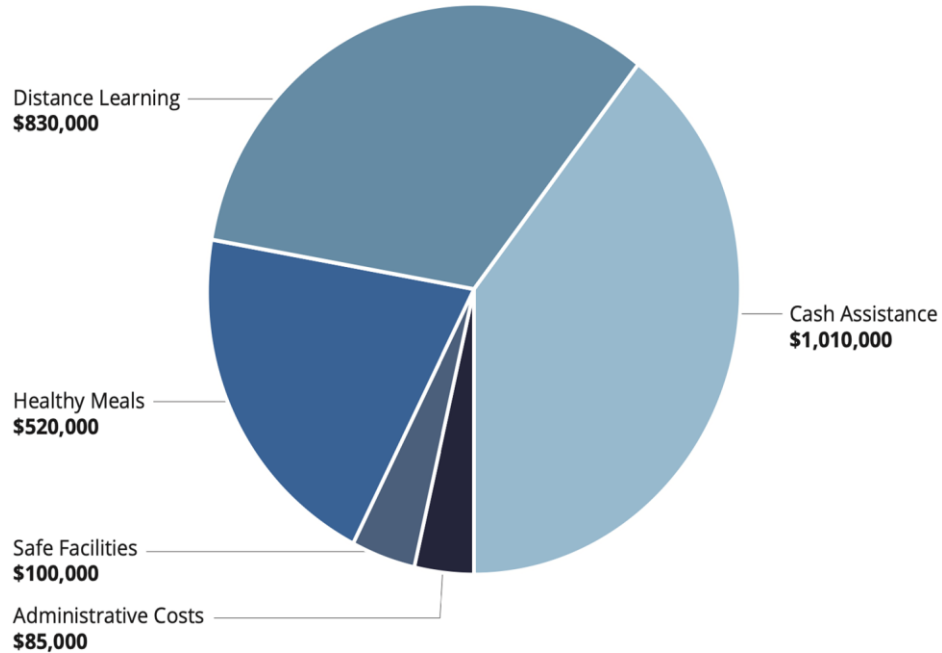

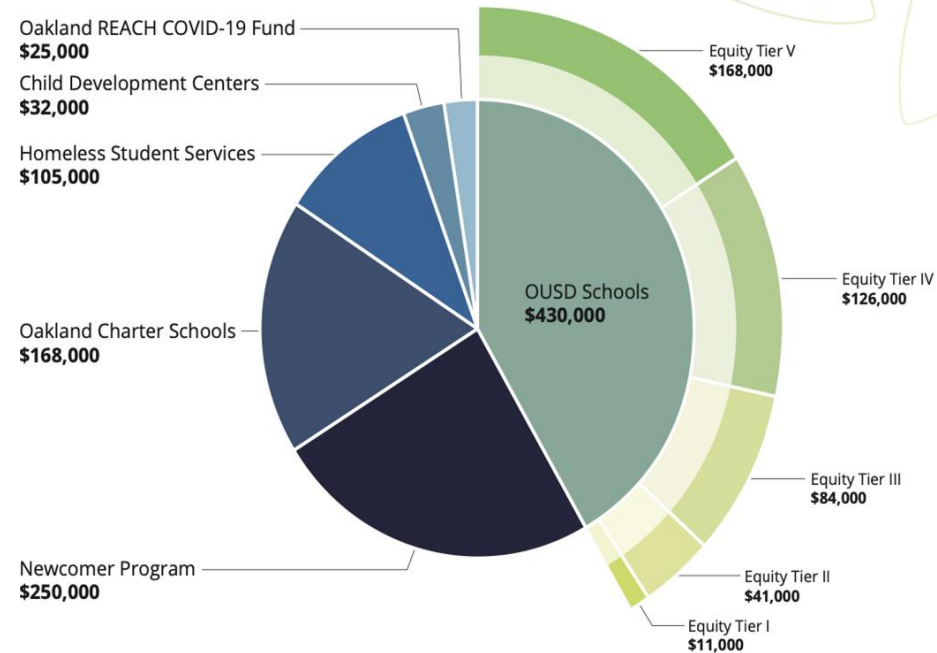


COVID-19 Rapid Relief Fund
