Elena Comrie, Project Manager, Facilities Planning and Management, presented Change Order No. 4, Agreement Between Owner and Contractor by and between the District and Arntz Builders, Inc., Petaluma, CA, for additional construction services which includes PCO's 15 and 47-56, request for approval of various contract changes, as delineated in Change Order, incorporated herein by reference as though fully set forth, for the Cole Campus Central Administration Center Project, in the additional amount of \$2,315,466.06, increasing the Agreement amount from \$40,025,863.82 to \$42,341,329.88. and extending the contract term by 431 calendar days, ending April 15, 2024. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect, approved by the Board of Education on February 14, 2024, Enactment No. 24-0284.

Project Manager Comrie and Kenya Chatman, Executive Director, Facilities Planning and Management, responded to comments and questions from the Committee.

- Project Manager Comrie provided an overview of Change Order (CO) No. 4, such as added stair case, sewer adjustments, inflation, and General Contracts.
- Several BJY Committee Members raised concerns regarding the addition of the stair case and that it should not have been added to the scope of this

project.

- Chairperson Dawson requested COs come to BJY Committee first before going to Facilities Committee and/or Board of Education.
- Facilities Staff estimates an additional \$5 Million budget augmentation to the Central Administrative Center at Cole at a future date to be determined.
- BJY Committee requested CO No. 5 for the Central Administration Center Project at Cole Campus be brought to BJY Committee at it's next meeting with an updated Project Fact Sheet.
- Member Nelson stated, there is a process problem as these COs only come to BJY Committee and the Board of Education when it is too late for any changes to be made.
- Facilities Staff mentioned that 10% of contract is staff discretionary funds.
- BJY Committee Members expressed confusion regarding the 10% staff discretionary funds and questioned if that has been spent already due to the Fact Sheet for Central Administrative Center at Cole project showing staff discretionary funds at 18%.
- Chairperson Dawson stated that staff discretionary funds is a policy choice.
- Chairperson Dawson requested BJY Committee to be notified when there is discretionary spending in COs.
