### G. President's Statement of Reportable Action Taken In First Closed Session and the Vote or Abstention of Members Present, If Any

President Kakishiba stated that there is one Reportable Action from Closed Session and that Executive Assistant Mr. Rakestraw will report it out. Mr. Rakestraw stated the Board voted to settle the matter – Legislative File No. 13-1825. After the 1999 fire storm, the City established a City-wide Assessment District in which the District as a property owner was required to pay \$10,000 annually for fire abatement prevention in the hills. The District during State Administration and subsequent to that until this date had not paid the assessments, which amounted to more than \$250,000, said Mr. Rakestraw. Mr. Rakestraw stated, accordingly, the City of Oakland and the District have agreed to settle the matter by the District paying back [and current year] assessments, amounting to \$102,232.64. The vote to settle, moved by Director London and Seconded by Director Dobbins, with six (6) members [voted "Aye" - Directors London, Torres, Dobbins, Harris, Vice President Hinton-Hodge, President Kakishiba], with Director Anne Washington Recusing herself because she is an employee of the City of Oakland.
