President Kakishiba stated in Closed Session today the Board of Education voted 5-0 to approve a settlement agreement with the American Indian Model School (AIMS) containing the following terms:

1. Cessation of all current legal proceedings.

2. An agreement not to resume revocation proceedings based on conduct leading to the March 2013 revocation of the AIMS Charters.

3. Mutual resolution of outstanding financial issues including AIMS potential claims for attorney fees and costs from litigation following the revocation and AIMS share of the Special Education contribution for fiscal year 2013/2014. After reconciling these respective financial issues, AIMS will pay the District the sum of \$28,923.73 no later than 30 days following the finalization of this settlement.
