# I. Special Recognitions and Presentations

President Harris said the Board and the public will observe a moment of silence tonight in memory of District students lost to violence since July 2013.

Director Senn began by reading this passage aloud. "When a parent or child is taken away too soon, a ripple effect of pain and loss is felt throughout our community. The death of a parent or child is like a stone cast in the stillness of quite cold, the ripple effect sweeping out in all directions affecting many, many people."

President Harris said tonight we are going to read the names of District students that our community has lost due to violence since July 2013 and then pause for a moment to remember all Oakland children and parents that we have lost. He said we hope we have not missed anyone, but if so, please say their name while acknowledging a name. A Stone of Hope will be passed throughout to those in attendance tonight. While you hold the stone, please take a moment to think about how you can shift the ripple of despair to a ripple of hope in our community so that all of our children and families can thrive.

A moment of silence was observed by everyone in attendance.

Director Senn began the passing of the "Stone of Hope". President Harris asked everyone to touch the stone and to return the stone to Ms. Floyd, who will return it to Superintendent Wilson to complete the circle of hope.

Superintendent Wilson began with the reading of the names followed by each Board Member reading a name: Alquino Rivera, Lee Weathersby III, Darnell Foster, Brandon Tolliver, Denzel Jones, Willie Gilbert, Samatha Alvarado, Isaiah Smith, and Davon Ellis. The youngest was 13 and the oldest 18. May their memories be a blessing.
