# **15-0703** District Audit Findings - Responses Fiscal Year 2010-11 and Fiscal Year 2011-12

Presentation to the Audit Committee of the status of the prior year Audit Findings and District responses for Fiscal Year 2010-2011 and Fiscal Year 2011-2012.

Staff presentation by Ruth Alhaydoian.

Ms. Alhaydoian said since 2003, the State Controller's Office has been solely responsible for the audit of District finances. She said as a result of that, audits have taken longer to complete. Currently the State is auditing 2012/13 fiscal year. The 2011/12 audit was just completed in November and the 2010/11 was completed in May 2013. She said there was two years with no audit because the District was so far behind, the State was asked to skip two years so not to be further behind. As a result, by the time the State Controller reviews, the District is several year past and too late to implement the next year. There are several years of findings after the issue has been identified and then too late to make changes. On the 2011/12 audit there were 24 findings; 12 were State compliance issues with financial implications in the amount of \$1.4 million; 11 Federal findings totaling \$500,000; and 1 financial finding with no financial implication (no processes in place to audit Student Body Funds at school site). The Federal findings were appealed at the State level and the State wanted to know why the findings were repeat findings? The District has been providing this information to the State Controller's Office. The State level findings were appealed to the Education Audits Appeal Panel and the District has been waiting over a year for a response since 2013 on old audits and the District is in the process of negotiating the findings.

Beverly Hansen wanted to know if there is a cost associated with the State and Federal appeals?

Ms. Alhaydoian said Federal findings totaled about \$500,000 for Time Accounting of State and Federal Staff. The State findings totaled about \$1.388 million primarily for attendance records at schools sites. Ms. Alhaydoian said through the appeals process, these findings and others, the District is providing more evidence to the State and have shown that the standard the State Controller's Office was using was not standard procedure for school districts. The District has evidence in its data information systems that may not be dated properly.

*Ms.* Sutton asked for clarification on the administrative ratio finding whether there too many administrators or not enough .

*Mr.* Menyon replied there too many administrators. He said it is how the District tracked the numbers and the State has a different scope than the District. He said there is a ratio of administrators for teachers and the District exceeded the number of administrators

*Ms.* Hanson asked if there would be a financial penalty for not paying the State and Federal findings because it is in the appeals process?

Ms. Alhaydoian said not that she was aware of.
