David Chambliss gave a report on the schools three years strategic plan around Measure N.

- 1. The tool has the four pillars, there is a section in the tool for each of the pillar you would state what are the goals, what are the targets, and that would be follow by data analysis of strengths and challenges for those specific indicators that was chosen.
- 2. Section called root caused analysis, which looks at where the challenges are or area need of improvement, what are the reasons why there's challenges and by clearly identifying those, then follow with the practices strategy and practices to implement those challenges. Practices are broken out by teacher practices, Leadership practices, and organizational practices. After the practices are defined they often have budget action behind them
- 3. In design, it is really meant to be a tool that leads into a final budgeting session. Work within the tool, use the tool to define ultimately what are the budget expenditure would be and the tool set it up to go into budget session with other staff and lock in the plan for the next year as expected to send the fund.

There was a dialog between Measure N Commissioners and Mr. Chambliss in regards to 3year versus 1 year cycle and the budgets side or Measure N. Chairperson, David Kakishiba requested a visual orientation of the Single Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA) Tool.
