Examining Audit Report Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2015

Presentation was given by Lillard Danna, Partner that is in charge of the Audit for the Oakland Unified School District for the Parcel Tax Audit. He stated:

- There was a typo in the report and it should have said, "We noted "no" errors in...."; it's corrected
- Audit is essentially a test of expenditure that goes through the parcel tax fund
- Spent of specific items that are in line with the budget measure
- Make sure that the monies in the general category agree to the ballot measure
- Up to date on the Audits on the parcel tax; general Audit are still one audit cycle behind
- Select detail expenditure to items and test them for validity to make sure that it represents real money that is really been paid and that it's a real teacher
- Test allocations to make sure that they are in line with what the district had originally allocated
- Tested County Collection fee which is about 1 ½ percent taken out from parcel tax because they are collecting the tax on the district's behalf
- Tested revenue that comes in

Budget Director Sandra Anderson-Knox asked if there were any changes to the draft of the Measure G Parcel Tax Citizens' Oversight Committee Annual Report Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2015:

- Vice Chair Daniel Bellino asked if the Committee could have 5 as the maximum membership instead of having 7 members due to lack of making quorum
- Vice Chair Daniel Bellino wanted to include the class size reduction chart to help paint the picture of what's in the text under Programmatic and Financial Summary and pull out the \$5.4 Million spent had an impact on lowering class size by 1.29 students
- Vice Chair Daniel Bellino wants to include under County Collection Fee the language that states that Measure G Committee did look into if the fee is negotiable, but it's not negotiable
- Committee Member John Baldo added some language sum to up the theme for last year which as the website and few screenshots in more transparency and more openness
- John Baldo added a new request to the Board for the Measure G Committee's intent is to do more community outreach, be a voice for the community
- Chairperson Bradley Mart stated, he would like to have a running report so instead of snap shots from the last 12 months, to have something that is cumulative from month to month
- The intention is to make Measure G Committee more robust. The Measure G Committee may vote and approve it, the Measure G Committee don't feel that it's a reflection of all of the intentions and plans; not a comprehensive document that expresses the direction of the Committee at this point

Kari Hatch spoke about:

- Read through the Annual report and glad that it's still a draft
- Important to get the Annual Report as accurate as possible
- "Funding for school libraries is allocated to stipend for teachers," is not correct for 14-15 school year
- The only salary and benefit that was paid out of the \$86,000 was for Lai Fong, who was Anne Gallaher's assistant, no teacher stipend
- The Measure G school libraries hasn't and shouldn't go to class room libraries

Chairperson David Kakishiba from Measure N Commission made a presentation and stated the following:

- Measure N was a parcel tax election that was held in November 2014
- Measure N is unique from other parcel tax Measure around the state
- Singular focus on investing in and seeking to foster a systemic improvement process with all high schools including district run high schools and independent charter run high schools
- Strengthens significantly the hand of the citizen oversight body
- Establishing it as entity does the oversight on the backend, but also on the front end
- 90% of all dollars go directly to school sites on a person basis
- Before a school can actually receive those dollars the schools must engage in a fairly rigorous school planning process; brings together various stakeholders in their school community
- Look at their student performance data
- Self-evaluation of where their school is at in term of both quantity and quality of establishing small learning communities that place co-hort of students in their school in career base pathways
- Personalized student supports both on academic as well as on the social and emotional side of life
- Schools submit the proposal then the district staff review those and makes recommendations
- July 1st those dollars will be release for implementation
- If monies are unexpended or school this year was unable to do a good planning process, those dollars can be planned for next year
- 10% from the admiration side can be carry over from year to year

After the presentation by Chairperson David Kakishiba from Measure N Commission, there was a discussion with the Committee about:

- The Commission is the advisor to the Board
- Career Pathways are not programs that enable a young person to get a career track position when they turn 18
- It's a strategy for student engagement in their own learning process
- Getting young people to explore the things that they get out of high school
- Meeting twice a month; initially there was a ton of work to do to ramp up the whole measure

- Right now the amount of leg work is less; It's in the hands of schools
- School visits are tremendous experience for all of the Commissioners and staff
- Seeing in real time changes the knowledge and behavior of school leaders and how they are approaching organizational planning for their school
- The Commission doesn't have constant contact with the school Board
- School Board made appointments
- Have not receive any request or directive from the Board on anything on particular
- Get the Board to be aware of the Commission recommendations and to request the
- The district staff will have to develop a report process
- The Measure N Commission will recommend to the Board to issue a Request for Proposal for an independent 3rd party evaluator
- Still discussing on the roll over monies and for how many years
- Working on a webpage where measure information will be housed
