- Final stages of finalizing their Measure N Plans that is embedded in the Single Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA)
- All the school sites are scheduled for their Education Improvement Plan (EIP's) presentation to the Commission

After the report there was discussion between the Commissioners and Preston Thomas regarding:

- How does the Commissioners want the feedback around the recommendations from the staff?
- Would like a summary written document and staff to have an opinion prior to the presentation
- Would like to hear the presentation first before staff's recommendations
- After the presentation from the schools, Commissioner have one week in advance before the May 17th meeting to take a look at staff's recommendation
- Having some kind of tools for the Commissioners to collect questions and thoughts that don't have to be part of the Question and Answer format, instead be a formalized way of being able to share thoughts, feelings, and recommendations
- Noticing a lot of leadership turnover reassurance that failure to have a high quality plan is result of factors that is beyond the control of the team
- There is stability in funding, so the site doesn't have to feel the pressure to spend the money now and that, is a bold move and helped stabilized school sites
- ½ hour for small schools presentation and 1 hour for the large schools presentation
