Discussion by the Measure G Parcel Tax Independent Citizens Oversight Committee with Ruth Alahydoian, Chief Financial Officer, or designee(s), on possible inclusion of all public schools - District and District authorized schools - in Measure G allocations.

Ruth Alahydoian, Chief Financial Officer, shared what Equity Pledge work is and how if

affect Measure G:

- Equity Pledge group is comprised of District and Charter School staff, Board members, representatives
- Building communications network between charters and public schools
- Partly driven by two major things:

Enrollment and Measure G

- Starting with 2017-2018 school year, will be taking some of Measure G and having it available to charters; three-year phase in for approximately \$5 million

After the report, there were discussion regarding:

- What would be the responsibilities be as a Measure G Committee? Regarding Oversight?
- Charter would have to spend the Measure G money according to the same guideline
- How much of Measure G money would go to charters and what would that process look like
- Would Measure G funding only go out to Oakland students who are residence of Oakland or students in Oakland?
- District and District authorized schools

Daniel Bellino, Vice Chair, said the Committee wanted a regular check in or report on the Equity Pledge until the plan is in place.

Dan Bellino, Vice Chair, wanted to put one of the Committee members as part of Equity Pledge group, but Executive Assistant, Edgar Rakestraw recommend to seek General Counsel advice before doing so because of the conflict of interest given that the committee is an Independent Oversight Committee.

Bradley Mart, Chair, also asked if the General Counsel does not recommend it, then is it ok for someone in the Committee to sit in the group so the Committee can be kept abreast about activities?

Staff will check with General Counsel regarding appointment for Equity Pledge Group.

Committee - Measure G Funds - LCAP Process

Chief Financial Officer, Ruth Alahydoian shared the Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) process. She shared:

- All school in the districts in the state of California are now required to submit one
- LCAP process get approves by the Board right before the budget get approved
- LCAP includes the goals for the district, the state has 6 or 7 goals and the district have to address those goals
- Have to have indicators showing how those goals would be reached; what type of measures would be used to obtain the goals
- What are the action items that the district is doing to meet those goals?
- What is the budget associated with the action items?
- Measure G was pulled out in the dollars that was given to schools for library materials, and educator effectiveness those were the two sources of dollars that were gave to schools that was specifically labeled Measure G
- Schools reported how they spent Measure G dollars, it is included those in LCAP

After the sharing of LCAP there was discussion regarding if there was community engagement input on how the Measure G dollars are spent within the LCAP.

A discussion was developed regarding if Measure G were considered restricted or unrestricted.

Ruth Alahydoian, Chief Financial Officer, said she checked with the Alameda County of Education whether Measure G is considered unrestricted or restricted. She said Alameda County of Education said it's up to the District and since its designated as unrestricted to

leave it as is.
