Superintendent Wilson reminded everyone of the District's

Mission: A Full Service Community District focused on high academic achievement while serving the whole child, eliminating inequity, and providing each child with excellent teachers, every day. Our Vision - OUSD students will find joy in their academic experience while graduating with the skills to ensure they are caring, competent, fully-informed, critical thinkers who are prepared for college, career, and community success.

It is important to appreciate our students lives and their experiences, their prospective, they bring with them into our schools, so it's important to take the time and create spaces in our schools for our students to share and to lead.
