David Kakishiba, Chairperson introduced the agenda item, research questions, 2016-2017 participatory action research plan regarding:

- What is the main key research questions that Measure N Commision wants to study as part of the evaluation

John Watkins, Coordinator, Linked Learning Coaches, spoke on:

- Looking at 3 different parts: Evaluation of design process, Implementation evaluations, and Outcomes and impact evaluations
- Rework the logic model that was design a couple of years ago so it's more accurately reflects the Measure N work that people are doing and what was learned
- To take the revised logic model and then developed research questions base on each of those elements from the logic model
- The research questions begin on page 6 and they aligned with outline which is similar to the logic model

After, John Watkins, Coordinator, Linked Learning Coaches shared, there were a discussion between the Commissioners and staffs regarding:

- As participants were bringing up new areas of interest or focus groups or individual interviews that the design would morph to include some of the interest that pop up
- Interested in the process that has been developed to hold the work of schools and design teams stand at support or hinders to school design team
- Interested in the idea of thriving and what thriving means; what does thriving look like or mean
- As organizationally we have the obligation to set the condition by which student do thrive
- Is there a way to evaluate if students are thriving, are they getting excited about it, whether does the parents knows about thriving?
- What is the theory of action for the work that Linked Learning High School Office (LLHSO) are doing
- What is LLHSO planning for this coming year base upon what was learned
- Just because it's a good idea doesn't mean its reaching the 5 measure N goals
- To look at how the money is invested to support the 5 measure N goals
- Look at Charter school to have a report
- To have some kind of report to include when the waiver is put out for the 65 years old and over
- Every single schools including charter will have a some short of one pager understanding the funding is being spent
- When Voluntary Resolution was passed, what's the level of knowledge and understanding among the professionals in a school campus about the linked learning approach
- What is the presenting things that Linked Learning have to deal with now?
- How can it be assess that the whole district is speaking the same language and consistent in term of the work
- The context for teachers when Measure N got rolled out
- How Oakland is understanding Linked Learning
- Use Oakland Promise as a supporting campaign for Measure N Commission
