F. Executive Director's Report

16-2207 Measure N Commission - Executive Director's Report

Update on Measure N matters status.

Preston Thomas, Executive Director College and Career Readiness made a report on:

- Madison Park Academy had issue with the accreditation that was impacting A-G status
- Affecting students to apply and attend college
- Was able to expedite the accreditation process and they are being accredited

After the report, the Commissioners and Staff discussed about:

- Without the accreditation the school does not have the formal recognition of UC's and CSU's
- People are in place because of the Measure N planning process and thinking about college readiness and transitioning students into college that there are actual people to support the students and families
- The Communication department needs to be at the meeting to see the fantastic work that Measure N is funding
- What kind of implications experience at one school site has around school redesigning great clusters sit in the network system?

Preston Thomas introduced Josue Diaz, one of the Co-Principal from Oakland Technical High School to share out what's happening at his school.

Josue Diaz, Co-Principal shared:

- How do we support students and who needs the most support?
- Looking at opening up a new pathway with 120+ students
- Looking at different data to determine what type of pathway
- Leaning toward Humanity's Pathway
- Created Master Schedule Team
- Started the day later at 9:00; seen tardiness in students dropped drastically Great improvement in school culture
- Computer Science class is doing great; computer science academy double in size
- Hired 4 Student Support Specialists with helps a lot

After sharing Josue Diaz and the Commissioners discussed about:

- How is Humanity connected to a pathway and become a career?
- What does humanities look like at Oakland Tech High School?
- Trying to define the language that are using that it's a non-STEM pathway
- Visiting other pathways in Las Angeles, Southern California, and locally in the Bay
- What language should be used in term of helping the conversation with the design team
- Want to STEM pathways really open up equitably for girls and that was noticed that there were no girls in the room
- Went from 1 to 5 Computer Science teachers; 3 Computer Science teachers dedicated to 9th grade
- 1 of the 3 is a female Computer Science teacher
- There are a lot of things that are targeted for the female students in the Computer Science Academy
- Because of Measure N, one Humanity teacher was hired to relieve 3 other teachers to build their capacity to become an academy director
- 4 computer science teachers, 3 for the 9th grade and 1 for grades 10 and 11
- 3 Student Support Specialists
- 1 Case Manager that works directly with an academy for high targets students
- Computer animation is part of Fashion Arts and Design Academy (FADA)
- Prioritizing pathways and the students that need it first
- The staff determining, base upon industry sectors, what are legitimate and valuable and socially relevant career academies
- Designing a template for every school to have on how the Measure N money is being expended
- Opportunities as a Commission to visit schools and places like Denver or Nashville
