Shonda Scott, 360 Concepts, made the 2017 Local Business Utilization Report to the Board. Three Sixty Concepts (Team 360) is the District's contract compliance team overseeing the Local Business Program to ensure policy requirements are met. Ms. Scott said the District's goal is to have Procurement under the same 50% requirement as the Capital Program. Team 360 created a campaign to brief department heads on the Local Business Program and the importance of spending District money with the local community.

Highlights

- Research has shown that when using a local business, seventy-eight cents of every dollar spent is recycled back into the city's economy.
- In 2008, OUSD Board of Education passed its first Local/Small Local Business Policy establishing all District contracts met 20% local business utilization (LBU) requirements.
- In 2014, the Board amended its policy to increase LBU on Capital Program to 50% requirement of all contracts.

Types of businesses in the City of Oakland

Local Business (LBE)

Business has a substantial presence in the District's boundaries and operational for 12 consecutive months.

Small, Local Business (SLBE)

Business meets the size standard set by the District for small businesses; headquartered in the District's boundaries with a substantial presence; and conducting business for at least 12 consecutive months

Small, Local Resident Business (SLRBE)

Business meets the size standard set by the District for small businesses; wholly owned and operated by persons whose principal place of residence is located within District's boundaries; conducting business for at least 12 consecutive months.

All businesses must hold a valid business tax certificate.

President Harris provided updates on the Superintendent search, District Budget, and AC Transit.

President Harris said the Board met yesterday in Closed Session to review 35 applications submitted for the Superintendent of Schools and said most were from California. Harris said there was a significant attempt to identify Latino candidates by expanding the search to the Southwest.

Superintendent Search Update

- Narrowed the pool of candidates down to 5-7
- April 22nd the Board will meet in Closed Session to interview these candidates further narrowing the pool down to 2 or 3 candidates.
- April 23rd two community panels will interview the finalists; each Board Member will select a person from their district
- Residents of the City and Labor Partners (OEA, ASFME, UAOS, etc.)
- The Board hopes to have the field of candidate narrowed down to 2 finalists at the end of the two days of interviews and present a finalist to the public at the April 26th Board Meeting
- Updates are forth coming

Budget Update

- The highest priority of the Board is no budget cuts to school sites (only essential) and student safety
- Sixty-five percent of all new revenue received this school year went to teacher salary increases
- The Board has to look at the number of charter schools operated by the District
- After consultation with County Superintendent Karen Monroe, Senior Business Officer, and Interim Superintendent, the District will engage Financial Crisis Management Assistance Team (FCMAT) to look at the District's financial books.

AC Transit Update

- The goal is to stay at the negotiating table and work out a resolution to preserve service for the students that require service
- Will continue working with AC Transit to bring a positive solution and seek an agreement with AC Transit that is in-line with District new revenue system

Interim Superintendent Dr. Devin Dillon reported on her weekly school site visits. Dr. Dillon said she visited Acorn Woodland today and read to students the book Oakland A-Z.

Two students from Ralph Bunche School won a culinary arts competition and will travel to Washington, D.C.

Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) Budget Development - Interim Superintendent Devin Dillon introduced Dr. Kyla Johnson Trammell, Interim Deputy Superintendent for Social Emotional Learning.

Dr. Johnson Trammell said LCAP is a plan school where districts have to outline how key investments are developed in the students with the greatest need, ELAC, Foster Youth, low income and students with special needs.

Dr. Johnson Trammell provided a summary of the current work to date, the shift, the purpose of LCAP moving forward, and overview of the California Dashboard (data all California districts need to use to write the LCAP Plan and monitor the progress moving forward). A draft of the plan was submitted to Alameda County Office of Education on March 27, 2017.

Six Goal Areas

- Goal 1: Graduates are college and career ready.
- Goal 2: Students are proficient in state academic standards.
- Goal 3: Students are reading at or above grade level.
- Goal 4: English learners are reaching English fluency.
- Goal 5: Students are engaged in school every day.
- Goal 6: Parents and families are engaged in school.

In each Goal area, LCAP must address how programs and services are addressing the gaps for student groups that are performing well below the all-student average on the new state indicators.

Approval by the Board of Education of Board Policy - Business and Noninstructional Operations - BP 3470 - Debt Issuance and Management Policy, reflecting new law (SB 1029, 2016) which mandates that Boards adopt a debt management policy prior to issuing any debt, including, but not limited to, General Obligation Bonds, Tax and Revenue Anticipation Notes, and Certificates of Participation.
