The District has taken proactive steps to test drinking water at its school sites and child development centers. The steps the District has taken, the sites tested, and test results are available on the District's website

Board Policy 3511.3 sets forth a plan for water testing, communication, budgeting, and remediation.

Anticipated costs of remediation depend upon source of lead and a number of issues:

\$1.3M is an estimate from the District's building and grounds department for replacement of 1,117 fixtures (drinking fountains and kitchen faucets) across all district schools. Current test results do not demonstrate a need for replacement of all 1,117 fixtures.

\$16M is an estimate provided by Jacobs consulting based on a 5-year life cycle analysis for complete replacement of 4,800 fixtures of all types.

\$38M is an estimate from Jacobs consulting based on a life-cycle analysis (replacement based on age regardless of test results) and Portland Schools lead abatement budget where there are similarly aged buildings. This estimate is for a comprehensive process that includes sampling, testing, replacement of all fixtures based on a life cycle model (i.e., the \$16M identified above), replacement of water lines/ pipes, and project management.
