Mark Triplett, Middle School Network Superintendent, made the staff presentation.

Triplett reviewed revisions made to the Measure G1 Administration Regulation regarding Carryover Funds.

Removed - Disbursement of Measure G1 Funds on July 1st.

The process for District schools begin in the Spring with the budget development process. Schools will have access to Measure G1 Funds on July 1st.

All transactions using Measure G1 Funds require approval by the Middle School Office to ensure compliance with the Measure G1 Commission and Board of Education approved site plans.

The process is different for charter schools because the District doesn't have the ability to monitor charter school finances. A mid-year reimbursement process allows staff to monitor expenditures. There is also a end-of-year reimbursement process for any remaining expenditures.

Added to the Regulation

- -Creation of a mid-year and end-of-year reimbursement process
- -Expenditures must align with the site plan.
- -Middle Schools can make a request to the Measure G1 Commission to roll-over all unexpended Measure G1 funding allocations no more than one fiscal year
- -Schools will be notified of the carryover amount in the fall once the District has closed its books for the previous fiscal year

Linda Pulido, Middle School Network Partner talked about some changes to the Administrative Regulation.

- -Paragraph four Changed from a three year Education Improvement Plan to a one year education plan
- -Carryover reasons ranged from salary savings to not being able to move forward with their plan.
- -Madison Park Middle School has a negative (\$9,050.00).
- -All other schools have a positive carryover amount.

Triplett offered two recommendations for reconciling Madison Park Middle School negative balance.

- -Taking the negative amount out of the current year's allocation
- -Taking the negative amount out of 2019/2020 allocation.

Taking the amount out of the current year would be easier said Triplett, but the school had already determined how they would use the funds. Using next year's allocation provides notice to the school in advance.

Triplett said believes based on the expenditures submitted, staff believes the overage was due to the drama teacher costing more than allocated.
