Backfill boring with cement grout after completion of drilling; remove and properly dispose of spoils placed in 55-gal drums and provide a letter documenting the disposal with a copy of the waste disposal manifest. Perform a Detailed Liquefaction Study. in conjunction with the Arroyo Viejo CDC Building Replacement Project for the period commencing February 3, 2010 and concluding no later than December 31, 2011 in an amount not to exceed \$11,300.00.
