Title: Approval by the Board of Education of Amendment No. 2, Individual Service Agreement to the Master Memorandum of Understanding between the District and Bay Area Community Resources, San Rafael, CA, for the latter to provide Option A services for approximately 100-125 3rd-7th grade students, including program offerings that build and enhance students' basic technology and computer skills; prepare students for the SBAC assessment by exposing them to sample questions and practicing sample questions together; and increase students' participation in and knowledge of health and wellness behaviors/activities, at Greenleaf Elementary School, for the period of July 1, 2013 through August 22, 2014, in an additional amount of \$2,957.00, increasing the ISA not to exceed amount from \$181,815.00 to \$184,772.00. All other terms and conditions of the ISA remain in full force and effect.
