Title: Approval by the Board of Education of a Professional Services Contract between the District and Playworks, Oakland, CA, for the latter to provide 200 hours of service: use recess to coordinate the playing of core playground games and core sports; introduce skill -building exercises and cooperative games; coordinator is required to be at all regularly scheduled recess periods; offer teachers the option to have a class game time, to teach students and the teachers the rules, expectations, and skills of the games and activities; provide a Junior Coach program, to establish student leadership within the school and to build student ownership of some sea school functions; maintain and distribut the school playground equipment; provide two out-of-school program options: after-school or before school programming; after-school work with a maximum of 15 students up to four afternoons per week from 3-5 pm; before school coordinate recess up to 30 minutes before-school programming hours; and provide a Girls Basketball and Co-ed volleyball league at Manzanita Community School, for the period of August 27, 2012 through June 13, 2013, in an amount not to exceed \$12,000.00.
